Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

We received confirmation of a “Clenbuterol” positive from Dalare Associates, for urine Sample D-07780 collected on Monday, August 27, in the ninth race, for the horse “Butch Cassidy LZP”. We requested Commission Inspector Mr. Francis Swift to conduct a barn search this morning concerning the “Clenbuterol” positive. The barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer, Scott Powell were inspected. Results of the search revealed a one gallon container of compounded “Clenbuterol” manufactured in Nebraska.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 3:30 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:31 p.m.** The rider on the #1a, “First Show,” Yamil Rosario, was changed to Juan Molina; no double jocks mount. #4, “Echo Bye,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 4 - 5.”**  
**Starters - 7**

**SECOND RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:58 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:59 p.m.** #3, “Nitros Account,” was a vet scratch. #5, “First Friend,” #6, “Girl Wonder,” and #9, “Choir Girl,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 8 - 1.”**  
**Starters - 5**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 4:26 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:26 p.m.** #4, “L. C. Sleepy,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 2 - 5.”** **Starters - 6**

**FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:54 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:55 p.m.** Javier Santiago, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Miss Pavarotti,” was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr.; no double jocks mount. #4, “Rakehellish,” #5, “Blue Angel Express,” #7, “Gadget,” #8, “My Only One,” and #9, “Ghostly Chant,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #1, “Sister Earth,” was selected for a blood gas test. We called the rider of the #10, “Kitty Kat Karly,” Joe Rocco Jr. asking him why he had eased the horse down the stretch and past the wire. Mr. Rocco said the horse could not breathe. #10, “Kitty Kat Karly,” was sent for a Stewards special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 3 - 2.”** **Starters - 6**

**FOURTH RACE (continued) Follow-up on the report by the jockey:**

*“Kitty Kat Karly” upon arrival at the test barn was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian, John T. Peters who reported that he did not detect any infirmities in the horse and went through normal testing procedures without incident.*

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:22 p.m.** The rider on the #3, “Smoke’n Review,” Jose Betancourt, was changed to Juan Molina; no double jocks mount. #2, “Copper Tiger,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 5**

**SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 5:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:51 p.m.** #1, “Leroi’s Royal Lass,” and #2, “Vapour Musing (GB),” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #5, “Nokaze,” and #9, “Way Smarter,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 5**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 6:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 6:19 p.m.** #1a, “Pretty Witty,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Nellie,” and #6, “Include Me Sir,” were vet scratches. #7, “Joy Rising,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #2, “Beautiful One,” Joe Rocco Jr. pulled up at the three-eighths pole. The #2 was jogged back to the unsaddling area by the outrider appearing to be ok. The horse was also examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner, who reported that the horse appeared to be ok. We called the rider Mr. Rocco who said the horse would not stride out, pulling herself up. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 5**

*Note: Examination of the Equibase chart noted in “comments” that the horse “BEAUTIFUL ONE” as “pulled up, vanned off,” however this is not correct. Equibase will be contacted by the Stewards to make the correction to the chart. (DTRC Executive Director, John F. Wayne)*

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 6:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 6:46 p.m.** The rider on the #1, “Dancing Misty,” Jesus Bracho, was changed to Juan Molina; no double jocks mount. The #6, “Sergeant Pepper MHF,” was lugging in very bad down the stretch. We called the rider of the #6, Gregorio Rivera, to ask him what was wrong with the horse and he told us that the horse was lugging in, but he did not know why. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 7**
