Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, September 5, and Thursday, September, 6, 2012, were all clear.

Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing on Tuesday, September 11, 2012 for Vendor, Erika Rodriguez, for performing the duties of a Jockey Agent and failing to obtaining a license. Mrs. Rodriguez was issued a warning. Mrs. Rodriguez was also informed that she should not be acting as a jockey's agent when not properly licensed to do so.

We held a hearing on Tuesday, September 11, 2012, for Exercise Rider, Terrio Raheem Terry, for threatening a trainer and testing positive for Marijuana. Mr. Terry had been suspended pending his appearance before the Stewards, from a previously scheduled hearing. Mr. Terry will be required to attend and complete a Drug and Alcohol program and Anger Management counseling before seeking a future license.

We held a hearing on Tuesday, September 11, 2012 for Outrider, Mr. Eric Lato, for his alleged involvement with, and having a beneficial interest in the horse "Savannah Man" while being licensed as an outrider. After hearing all testimony and reviewing all the documents presented in the case, it was the Stewards decision that no action be taken.
