### **Administrative Hearings:**

A hearing was scheduled for trainer G. Scott Powell, and owner exercise rider Benacio Murillo, for a claiming violation concerning the horse "Litle Bit" from the ninth race on Saturday, September 1, 2012. The Stewards are still deliberating a penalty for this violation.

A hearing was held on Tuesday September 25, 2012 for trainer Greg Griffith concerning a feed bill owed to Greg Cischke, "Greg's hay and straw". Mr. Griffith has agreed to pay Mr. Cischke the remaining amount on the bill. Mr. Cischke has stopped delivering hay and straw to Mr. Griffith.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #2, "J's Hot Shot Lady,"** was a vet scratch. The #6, "Got it Covered," ridden by Martin Solis, pulled up lame after the race and was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown, who said the horse was off in the left front. The horse ambulance was requested to transport the horse back to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – "5 - 1 - 3 - 4." Starters - 6**

**SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m.** #1, “Kodiak Jack,” and #8, “Saints Preserve Us,” were vet scratches. #5, “Rapsandtaps,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 5 - 8.” Starters - 8**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.** #6, “Coin of the Realm,” was selected for a blood gas test. #5, “Falcon’s Flight,” Yomar Ortiz, reared up hitting the doors of the gate with her feet, opening the doors. At the same time the #6, “Coin of the Realm,” Vince Halliday broke through the gate, unseating the rider who held on to the horse. The #6 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, and loaded back in the gate to start. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 6**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m.** #3, “Stoltz,” was scratched, for being ineligible for the race conditions. #7, “Smart Executive,” was claimed by Gavin Ty Racing LLC & Exacta B S LLC – Julio Cartagena. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 6**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:15 p.m.** #2, “Rocket Reign,” #3, “Northern Evader,” and #4, “Libertyisawesome,” were vet scratches. #10, “Umpee,” was scratched by the stewards, as the van had broken down. #9, “Sombreado,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 8 - 9.” Starters – 7**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 8 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 8**

**SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m.** Alex Cintron, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Jerry n’ Elvis,” was changed to Kendrick Carmouche; no double jocks mount. #4, “Uncle Harry,” was scratched as the horse had gotten loose loading on the van. #6, “Wandering Kitten,” and #8, “Virginia Cavalier,” were vet scratches. #3, “Easton Jack,” and #7, “Siegfried,” were scratched as main track only. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 9 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 5**

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m.** #2, “Dancing Misty,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 6**
