SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m.
Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Dixie Dear,” was changed to Jose Flores; no
double jocks mount. #1a, “First Friend,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #9,
“Calypsogirl,” was a vet scratch. **INQUIRY IN FIRST TURN –** The #2, “Leroi’s Royal
Lass” ridden by Jose Caraballo, pulled up lame in the first turn, with the rider dismounting.
The #2, “Leroi’s Royal Lass” was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen
Picciano, who said the horse was lame in the right front, with a suspected cannon bone injury. Dr.
Picciano requested the horse ambulance transport the horse back to its stall. The #2, “Leroi’s
Royal Lass” was euthanized after X-rays were taken of the injury. Postmortem report to follow.
