Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, is substituting today.

Four Jockeys were randomly selected today for testing. All tests were negative.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:15 p.m. #1, “Worthy Wager,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #2, “Brothers Nicholas,” and #5, “Today’s Man,” were vet scratches. #1a, “Triplite,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 – 1a - 3 - 4.” Starters - 4**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:45 p.m. Christopher DeCarlo, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Fifth Ave Fancy,” was changed to Ricardo Feliciano; no double jocks mount. #1, “Jasper Lake,” and #3, “Liberty Wing,” were scratched as main-track only. #8, “Tubal,” and #9, “Throw the Dice,” were vet scratches. #5, “Schooldic,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 – (7 - 10) - 2.” (7 – 10) - Dead Heat for show. Starters – 6**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #1a, “Be Widgett,” and #2b, “Gail’s Stormy,” were scratched as part of same-owner entries. **INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START** – Shortly after the start the #3, “All Mettle,” ridden by Yomar Ortiz, ducked to the inside at the gap to the main track at the three-quarter pole and momentarily lost his left stirrup. Within a few strides, Ortiz was able to get his foot back into the stirrup and continued to ride the race to its conclusion. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #1a, “Summer Robin,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 1 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 9**

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m. #7, “Carnival Kid,” #9, “Calisi,” and #11, “Get it On,” were scratched as main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 10 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 8**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:45 p.m. #1, “Giacovani,” was a vet scratch. #6, “On the Go,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 5**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m. Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Wildlee Certain,” was changed to Huber Villa-Gomez; no double jocks mount. #7, “Francesco Punch,” and #10, “Flashy Bullet,” were scratched as main-track only. #11, “Bow Tie,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #12, “Safari Artie,” was scratched as an alternate. #3, “Great Investment,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START –** The #8, “Cure the Fever,” ridden by Alex Cintron, pulled up right out of the starting gate, with a broken left rear leg. The #8, “Cure the Fever,” was euthanized by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner. Post Mortem report to follow. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 13 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 9**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:45 p.m. Tyrone Carter, the scheduled rider on the #1a, “Doc Holidday,” was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount. #6, “In X Hess,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Miss Paradise,” Ricardo Santana Jr. was eased in the stretch and did not finish the race, pulling up just before the finish line. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 7**
