Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Saturday, October 6, and Monday, October 8, 2012, were all clear, with three exceptions. Sample #D-07245 collected on Saturday October 6, 2012 was positive for “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 4.48 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. Sample #D-07211 collected on Monday October 8, 2012 was positive for “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 3.42 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. No barn search was conducted, as both trainers ship in to run. Sample #D-07007 for Monday, October 8, 2012 is on hold by the official laboratory for further testing.

Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, is substituting today.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Jose Montano, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Nico the Champ,” was changed to Huber Villa-Gomez; no double jocks mount. #2, “Freuds Ana Streak,” and #9, “Brassy Boy,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #5, “Cabaret Cowboy,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Peter Boy,” ridden by Yomar Orlando Ortiz, started falling back at the three-eighths pole. #4, “Peter Boy,” was pulled in the stretch, falling after the rider had gotten off. Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, examined the horse “Peter Boy.” Dr. Brown reported that the horse had expired by the time he arrived on the scene. He made a preliminary diagnosis that “PETER BOY” may have ruptured an artery. A postmortem report will be forthcoming.
ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 7 - 6.” Starters – 7 (‘PETER BOY’ was sent to New Bolton Center for necropsy by order of the DRTC Executive Director)

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Osvaldo Vargas, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Savannah Man,” was changed to Yamil Rosario; no double jocks mount. #5, “A P Asset,” was a vet scratch. #1a, “Jaded Emperor,” and #7, “Easter Glory,” were scratched as main-track only. #6, “Wuthering,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 3 - 10 - 8.” Starters - 8**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:15 p.m. Osvaldo Vargas, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Spanish Blues,” was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr.; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 8 - 2.” Starters -8**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #9, “Tizsilk,” and #10, “Snap It,” were scratched as main-track only. #4, “Bowie Mill,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 10**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m. #1, “Jubileebra,” was scratched as the horse would not load into the van for shipping. **INQUIRY AT START –** The #4, “Easter Fashion,” Joshua Navarro, and the #5, “Wonder About Lola,” Ricardo Santana Jr. both broke outwardly at the start. The #6, “Ganesha,” ridden by Alex Cintron, broke in at the start bumping with the #5. No hold or claim of foul was lodged in this race. No action was taken, as both horses were to blame. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. Brian Pedroza, the scheduled rider on the #11, “Lights Out Lidge,” was changed to Juan Torres; no double jocks mount. #2, “Alisa’s Engineer,” #7, “Empire Caller,” and #10, “Ninth Client,” were scratched as main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 8 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – “THE 29TH RUNNING OF THE ENDINE STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. #1, “Sweet Cassiopeia,” #3, “Winnie Dixie,” and #5, “Roman Treasure,” were scratched as this is a stakes race. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 9 - 7.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - “THE DELAWARE PARK ARABIAN CLAIMING CHAMPIONSHIP STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:46 p.m. Yomar Orlando Ortiz, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Aim Hi,” was changed to Estebaun Unishuay; no double jocks mount. Mauricio Rodriguez, the scheduled rider on the #4, “D C Royale Tigre,” was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount. #1, “Aim Hi,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 – 1a - 5 – 1 - 3.” Starters - 7**
