Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, October 10, and Thursday, October 11, 2012, were all clear.

Administrative:

Associate Commission Veterinarian Nancy Vutz, is substituting today.

Four Jockeys were randomly selected today for testing. All four Jockeys tested were negative.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #9, “Lyrical Rhythms,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Screamforicecream,” was claimed by Joseph Besecker – Randy Nunley. #3, “Hot Cat Prospect,” was claimed by Home Team Stables – Scott Lake.
ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 9

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #1a, “Speedy Lee D,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #5, “Keypartner,” was scratched as a main track-only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 10 - 8 - 1.” Starters - 10**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:15 p.m. #1, “Who We Gunna Call,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Standup Comic,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #6, “Silent Appeal,” with rider Jeremy Rose bolted to the outside fence in the first turn. The rider Mr. Rose pulled the horse up. **INQUIRY AT START - #4, “Star Zaper,”** with rider Ricardo Santana Jr., broke through the gate just prior to the start, being held back by the assistant starter when the other horses broke from the gate. The Stewards determined the #4, “Star Zaper” was precluded from a fair start in this race. The #4 was declared a non-starter for all wagering purposes, with a refund of all wagers. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 7 - 5.” Starters - 5**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #1, “Flying Posse,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #3, “Exclusively Apple,” was selected for a blood gas test. #5, “War and Thunder,” was claimed by PTK LLC – Dane Kobiskie.
ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 6 – 1a.” Starters - 6

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. #10, “First Friend,” and #11, “Little Piasano,” were scratched as alternates. #7, “Sweetdreamsgalore,” was selected for a blood gas test. The race was originally cleared by the outriders, but a few minutes later the outriders called saying the #2, “Ella Marie,” with rider Omar Orlando Ortiz, wanted to put the race on hold and claim foul in the stretch. The hold and claim of foul were against the #4, “Laila Dundee,” with rider Alex Cintron, for coming out in the stretch causing him to steady his horse. After reviewing the films and talking to the riders involved, the #4 looked clear of the #2 when coming out down the stretch. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 9 - 7.” Starters - 9**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m. #1, “For All Who Conga,” and #2b, “Sting Boy,” were scratched as part of same owner entries. #2, “Laughter,” was claimed by The Elkstone Group – Ron Potts. #6, “Conflicting Report,” was claimed by Hugh Robinson – McClain Robinson. The owner and trainer that claimed the #6, “Conflicting Report,” requested a one hundred and seventy five (\$175.00) dollar all inclusive special test. The #6, “Conflicting Report,” ridden by Ricardo Santana Jr., pulled up lame after the race, was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who said the horse was off in the left front. The horse ambulance was requested to transport the horse back to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 – 1a - 4 - 3.” Starters – 8**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. #3, “Whatabootie,” #7, “Island Time,” and #8, “Marcie Lee,” were vet scratches. #1, “Check Point,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry and main-track only. #2, “Armarante,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #1, “Check Point,” and #5, “Giguaraya,” were scratched as a main-track only. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. The #4, “Pinch Pie,” stumbled at the start, breaking a step slowly. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 – 1a – 2b.” Starters - 4**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:45 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 8 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 8
