We approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Saturday, October 13, and Monday, October 15, 2012, were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. “The 20th Anniversary” – Kristina Mc Manigell, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Rock on Thelma,” was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount. #7, “Girl Wonder,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – “THE DTHA GOVERNORS DAY STAKES” - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #6, “Brave Tiger,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. **INQUIRY AT THREE-EIGHTS POLE** – Hold by Timothy Richey the trainer, of the #5, “Bid Till Included,” with rider Javier Santiago. The rider did not place this race on hold, but upon returning to the unsaddling area, Mr. Santiago claimed foul against the #2, “Forgotten Knot,” with rider Ricardo Santana Jr.; for coming in at the three-eighths pole causing him to have to steady his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the #2 did not come in at all but the #5 horse had no place to go, as the #1 horse who was in front was stopping, which caused the #5 to steady his mount. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 5 - 1.” Starters – 5**

THIRD RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:15 p.m.
“The Platinum Celebration” - #2, “Serious Attitude,” was a vet scratch. #1, Life’s a Roar,” #4, “Hold True,” #6, “Daddy Likes That,” and #7, “Special Energy,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #3, “Forest Jingles,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 9 - 10 - 3.” Starters - 5**

FOURTH RACE – “Owners Shine” - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m.
Due to a racing office mistake, on the entry of the #4, “Mason,” the claiming and the price should be \$6,500 instead of \$7,500, this was corrected by announcement, the correction was also posted on the claim box, and given to the Equibase chart callers. The corrected weight for the horse will be *110 pounds instead of *113 pounds, as listed in the program. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 7**
