We approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Four Jockeys were randomly selected today for testing. Three of the four Jockeys tested were negative. The fourth Jockey tested positive for amphetamines, which was prescribed by a Doctor. A copy of the prescription was presented.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Josue Arce, the scheduled rider on the #6, “City Genius,” was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr.; no double jocks mount. #3, “Mr. Windjammer,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 4 – 1a -5.”**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:45 p.m. Yamil Rosario, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Upper West Side,” was changed to Vince Halliday; no double jocks mount. #2, “Angel Rod,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Upper West Side,” was selected for a blood gas test. The saddle on the #4, “Face the Future,” with rider Yomar Orlando Ortiz, had slipped forward, onto the horses neck. #7, “Baltimore Bianca,” was claimed by Raul Arriagada – Alejandro Reyes. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 3 - 6.”** **Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #1a, “Wiseman’s Bluff #5, “Believe Its True,” and #7, “Onzain,” were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 2 - 3.”** **Starters -5**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #6, “Lucayan Princess,” was a vet scratch. The Jockey on the #2, “Rebecca Mia,” Tori Gandia, reported an incorrect weight to the clerk of scales, she said would weigh 112 lbs but could only do 115 lbs. Ms. Gandia will be issued a fifty (\$50.00) dollar fine for a first offense. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 6**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. Eduardo Rodriguez, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Wild Bopitys Boy,” was changed to Vince Halliday; no double jocks mount. #5, “Shot Gun Sen Sobel,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #7, “Maximotion,” ridden by Martin Solis, pulled up lame after the race at the seven-eighths pole. The #7 was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, who said the horse was off in the right front tendon. The horse ambulance was requested to transport the horse back to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 8**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. #5, “Jerry n’ Elvis,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 6**

We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 5 – 2b - 4.” Starters - 7**
