**LIVE RACING FOR TODAY WAS CANCELED DUE TO A LACK OF SUFFICIENT ENTRIES TO FILL THE RACING CARD.**

The Stewards have issued a decision on the two "Trenbolone" positives for trainer Carla Morgan. The penalty issued for the first positive test, concerning the horse "Day Dream Girl; Ms. Morgan will be fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars and receive a seven (7) day suspension. In addition the horse "Day Dream Girl" will be disqualified from all purse money.

The penalty issued for the second "Trenbolone" positive test, concerning the horse "Lady Olivia;" Ms. Morgan will be fined the sum of one-thousand (\$1000.00) dollars and a fifteen (15) day suspension. The horse "Lady Olivia," will be disqualified from all purse money.

The total penalty issued to Ms. Carla Morgan will be a fifteen hundred (\$1,500.00) dollar fine and 22 calendar day suspension. The effective dates on the twenty-two day suspension will be, the first twenty-two days of the 2013 racing season. Both horses are disqualified from all purse monies.

A hearing was scheduled for Tuesday, October 23, 2012, for Trainer G. Scott Powell. The hearing was for failure to have an attendant available for Salix administration, concerning the horse "Partin" which resulted in a scratch in the third (9<sup>th</sup>) race on Monday, October 6, 2012. After waiving his right to a hearing in this matter, trainer Powell will be fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars for this violation.
