Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:18 p.m. Silvia Zapico, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Catangelic,” was changed to Robert Paz.; no double jocks mount. Hold and claim of foul by the #3, “Is That Blue,” with rider Juan Torres, against the #5, “Gitanilla,” with rider Martin Solis, for coming in at the top of the stretch bumping with his horse, costing his horse third place. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race it looked like the #5 came in a step at the top of the stretch, along with the #3 coming out a step, which caused the bump. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 8 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 8**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #1a, “Runnin Da Fences,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #2, “Smok’n Review,” was a vet scratch. #8, “I Ain’t No Saint,” was scratched as the horse was a no-show to the paddock. The trainer Joseph Santoro, of the #8 will be issued a hearing notice for this violation. #3, “Masala,” was claimed by Joseph Besecker – Randy Nunley. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 3 - 7.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. After a two-way shake #6, “My Nobleman,” was claimed by Kryskaly Horse Racing Inc – Julio Cartagena. #8, “Mr. Titan,” was claimed by Susan Christenson – Leslie Glazier. #6, “My Nobleman,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 8 - 1 - 7.” Starters - 8**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. Carlos Esquilin, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Laberinto (URG),” was changed to Kristina McManigell; no double jocks mount. #1, “Peruano Smoke,” and #11, “Magic Lion,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 10 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 9**

The #5, “Forgetthefantasy,” and #6, “Olympic Medallist,” were scratched by Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters as both horses flipped in the starting gate getting injured. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 1 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 5**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. Yomar Orlando Ortiz, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Moe Larry Curly,” was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. #5, “Relentless Rush,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Mr Percussionist,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 7 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 6**
