Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, October 17, Thursday, October 18, Saturday, October 20, and Monday, October 22, 2012 were all clear.

Associate Commission Veterinarian Donna Moore, is substituting today.

We held a hearing today for trainer Joseph Santoro, for failure of his horse “I Ain’t No Saint” to show up in the paddock, for the Second race on Thursday, October 25, 2012. Also at the hearing were the two stable employees of the trainer who were involved in the case. After the hearing, we had the two grooms drug tested as a result of this incident. One groom tested positive for “Cocaine” and will be suspended pending his evaluation by the BEAP program coordinator Mr. Wes Jones. The other groom had the strong smell of alcohol about him, and was ordered to attend an evaluation by the BEAP program coordinator Mr. Wes Jones. The Trainer, Mr. Santoro will be held blameless in this matter. Administrative rulings shall be forthcoming.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #4, “Sting Boy,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 5**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #8, “Dream Every Dream,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 8**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #1, “Surprisedtoseeme,” was scratched in the post parade, by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner for not warming up well. **INQUIRY AT START - #2, “Gambine Road,”** turned his head just as the starter started the race, breaking very slow. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #2, “Fantastical,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Peruano Smoke,” was selected for a blood gas test. Samuel Bermudez, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Triple Vision,” was changed to Gregorio Rivera; no double jocks mount. #7, “Caldo Cat,” ridden by Daniel Centeno, was getting out around the first turn, being eased. Mr. Centeno told us that the harder he tried to keep the horse in, the more the horse got out. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 1 - 6 - 8.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #6, “Jango,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 7**
