Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Kevin Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Universal Soul,” was changed to Yomar Orlando Ortiz; no double jocks mount. #1, “Worthy Wager,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #1a, “Triplite,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Skip to the North,” was scratched for track conditions. #5, “Maji Moto,” was scratched by the trainer. #6, “Snap It,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Place and Show wagering for this race as we were below four betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 3**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Jorge Rodriguez, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Whowhathow,” was changed to Vince Halliday; no double jocks mount. #5, “Calling for Snow,” #6, “Unzapped,” and #8, “Demolisher,” were vet scratches. The #3, “Austerity Measures,” was scratched by Associate Commission Veterinarian Mary Durando, as the horse had injured its foot in the paddock. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 4**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. Kevin Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Economic Stimulus,” was changed to Martin Solis; no double jocks mount. #1, “Pumpidu,” and #2, “Jive Partner,” were vet scratches. #8, “Coin of the Realm,” was selected for a blood gas test. #6, “Kinginthecity,” was claimed by Hugh Robinson – Mclean Robinson. The owner and trainer that claimed the #6, “Kinginthecity,” requested a one hundred and seventy five (\$175.00) dollar all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #7, “Cooking up a Storm,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 6**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. Kevin Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Disembark,” was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr.; no double jocks mount. #2, “Armi Base,” was scratched for track conditions. #3, “Mister Mayhem,” and #7, “Heated,” were trainer scratches. #10, “Pylorus,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Deridder,” was claimed by Luch Racing Stables Inc – Jonas Gibson. #9, “Cherokee’s moonbeam,” was claimed by Jimmy Gilbert – Sam Cronk. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 11 - 6 - 8.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Common Ground,” was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. #8, “Ramblorghini,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #4, “Gambit’s Delight,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START –** Hold and claim of foul by the #5, “Kenni Rae,” with rider Alex Cintron, against the #6, “Hockessin Flash,” with rider Brian Pedroza, for coming in bumping him shortly after the start. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, it looked like the #2, “Goods Gone West,” with rider Javier Santiago broke outwardly, causing him to lose his left stirrup. This caused a chain reaction with all the horses outside of him bumping each other. Along with the #6 breaking inward slightly, which caused the #5 to be squeezed back. As this was a combination of factors from the inside and outside, no action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 8**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m. John Bisono, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Coach,” was changed to Jeremy Rose; no double jocks mount. #3, “Nik’s Star Choice,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Eternal Flight,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 8 - 1.” Starters - 7**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:50 p.m. Tyrone Carter, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Doc Holliday,” was changed to Juan Molina Jr.; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 4 – 1a - 7.” Starters - 8**
