SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #5, “Semester,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Gran Negro,” was selected for a blood gas test. #6, “War Reigns,” was claimed by Nick Sanna Stable LLC – Michael Pino. #8, “Time Has Come,” was claimed by Gail Patti – Owner Trainer. ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 1 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 8

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #1, “Neat Package,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Tsunami Wave,” was scratched by the trainer. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. ORDER OF FINISH – “2 – 1a - 5 - 3.” Starters - 5

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:45 p.m. #7, “Funny Accomodation,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Mr. Good,” was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 4 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 7

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #7, “Silverest,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2, “Fairly Royal,” was claimed by Runaway Point Farms LLC – Robert Triola. **INQUIRY AT THE TOP OF THE STRETCH** – Claim of foul by the #3, “She’s All Timber,” with rider Jose Caraballo, against the #1, “Halo Hollie,” with rider Martin Solis, for carrying him out from the three-eighths pole to the top of the stretch. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, the #1 carries out the #3 from the three-eighths pole to the top of the stretch. Consequently, the #1, “Halo Hollie,” was disqualified from second and placed fourth, behind the #3, “She’s All Timber” was advanced from fourth to third. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m. #9, “A True Imperialism,” was a vet scratch. #1, “La Valette,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2, “Island Blossom,” was claimed by Chemphar Inc. – Steve Epley. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 8 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 8**

SEVENTH RACE – “THE BELLAMY ROAD OVERNIGHT STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m. Jorge Rodriguez, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Ramblorghini,” was changed to Martin Solis; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:50 p.m. Jose Caraballo, the scheduled rider on the #1, “She’s Got Da Goods,” was changed to Martin Solis; no double jocks mount. #9, “Lyrical Rhythms,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 8 - 3 - 7.” Starters - 8**
