Approved scratches for today and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets.

Administrative

Trainer Wendy Uhacz came in this morning waiving her right to a hearing, and accepting the Stewards penalty of a thirty-day suspension and the fine of two thousand (\$2,000) dollars. The penalties are for her total base excess levels for two blood gas positives taken on Saturday, May 12, 2012 in the third and fifth races, in which the horses were scratched before running. The ruling will be forthcoming for this violation.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 pm. OFF TIME – 1:16 pm. #3, “Decisive Call,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 3 - 2.”**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 pm. OFF TIME – 1:46 pm. #1, “Cute Creation,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Prairie Trip,” was scratched by the racing office. #8, “Cover Ur Heart,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 5 - 3 - 7.”** After a two-way shake, the #3, “Kairos,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #3, “Kairos,” requested a one hundred and seventy five (\$175.00) dollar all inclusive special test. The #6, “Gold On Gold,” was claimed by Brooklyn Farm – Julio Cartagena.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 pm. OFF TIME – 2:16 pm. #2, “Sli Na Garpple,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 4 - 2.”** **INQUIRY -** The #3, “Mchanga,” Joseph Rocco Jr. fell just before the finish line. The #2, “Sli Na Garpple,” Yamil Rosario, fell over the #3 after the finish line. We waited until we received a copy of the finish photo before posting this race official, to see if the #3 had carried his jockey over the finish line, which he had not. The #3 was determined unplaced, as he did not finish the race. Jockey Joe Rocco Jr. was taken to first aid to be evaluated. EMT Mike Cooper called the Stewards stating that Mr. Rocco seemed to be ok, but would be going to the hospital for further evaluation. Jockey Yamil Rosario was taken directly to Hospital to be evaluated.

Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner examined the #3, "Mchanga," and diagnosed that it had sustained a fractured cannon bone. Due to the catastrophic injury, Dr. Teichner euthanized the horse. Post mortem report to follow.

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 pm. OFF TIME – 2:47 pm. #1, "Red Thorn," was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, "Warrensburg," was selected for a blood gas test. The rider on the 4, "Dubai's Debut," Mr. Yamil Rosario was changed to Mr. Robert Paz, as Mr. Rosario was taken off, due to the incident in the third race. **ORDER OF FINISH – "1a - 2 - 3 - 6."**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 pm. OFF TIME – 3:17 pm. The rider on the #2, "Laynee's Moose," Mr. Joe Rocco Jr. was changed to Mr. Javier Santiago, as Mr. Rocco Jr. was taken off, due to the incident in the third race. **ORDER OF FINISH – "1 - 2 - 4 - 3."**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 pm. OFF TIME – 3:49 pm. The rider on the #5, "Quarters," Mr. Joe Rocco Jr. was changed to Mr. Alex Cintron, as Mr. Rocco Jr. was taken off, due to the incident in the third race. #4, "Ravine's Song," was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – "7 - 5 - 2 - 6."**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:16 pm. OFF TIME – 4:19 pm. #7, "Someone Saweet," was selected for a blood gas test. #6, "Jamie's Ticket," Mr. Yamil Rosario was changed to Mr. Robert Paz, as Mr. Rosario was taken off, due to the incident in the third race. The #2, "Harbor Fox," was claimed by Brooklyn Farm – Julio Cartagena. #3, "Awe So Beautiful," was selected for a Stewards special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – "2 - 5 - 4 - 1."**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:47 pm. OFF TIME – 4:50 pm. The rider on the #3, "Vigilante Law," Mr. Joe Rocco Jr. was changed to Mr. Able Castellano Jr., as Mr. Rocco Jr. was taken off, due to the incident in the third race. #1, "Isabull," who was ridden by Alex Cintron, was eased at the three-eighths pole. The #1, "Isabull," was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who said the horse was off in the right front. Dr. Teichner requested the horse ambulance to transport the horse back to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – "2 - 4 - 6 - 5."**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:17 pm. OFF TIME – 5:20 pm. The rider on the #2, "Misty Dancer," Mr. Juan Molina Jr., was changed to Mr. Falah Bugheniam by the trainer. The rider on the #5, "A F Big Red," Mr. Yamil Rosario was changed to Mr. Juan Molina Jr. as Mr. Rosario was taken off, due to the incident in the third race. #1a, "Chiquita Rose," was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, "A F Big Red," was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT START –** It looked to us as though the #3, "D C West Wing," had broken through the gate just prior to the start. After reviewing the films the #3 did not receive an unfair advantage, as the gates all opened at the same time for all the horses. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – "2 - 6 - 4 - 1."**
