OFF TIME – 3:17 pm.** #1, “Shameless,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #8, “Riveting,” was scratched as the horse ran yesterday at Parx in the 6<sup>th</sup> race. A hearing notice will be sent to the trainer Mr. Anthony Dutrow. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 10 - 2 - 3.”**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 pm. OFF TIME – 3:46 pm.** #1, “Runnin Da Fences,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #4, “Knocked Out,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 3 - 8 - 5.”**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 pm. OFF TIME – 4:49 pm.** The rider on the #1, “Next Level,” Mr. Xavier Perez was changed to Mr. Joshua Navarro; no double jocks mount. #7, “One Hot Toddy,” was a vet scratch. #9, “And Why Not,” was scratched as a main-track only. #8, “Princess Minerva,” who was ridden by Jeremy Rose was eased, pulling up after the race. “Princess Minerva,” was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen Picciano, who diagnosed the horse’s condition as being sore. Dr. Picciano requested the horse ambulance transport and return the horse to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 6 - 12.”**

**NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:15 pm. OFF TIME – 5:16 pm.** #3, “Uncorked,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Md Sugar and Spice,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 2 - 1.”**
