We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #3, “Green Glory,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Halo Hollie,” was claimed by Brooklyn Farms – Julio Cartagena. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 5 - 3.”**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:14 pm. OFF TIME – 4:17 pm. The rider on #3, “Kendalls Bear,” Julian Pimentel was changed to Alex Cintron; No double jocks mount. #8, “Momma’s Happy,” was selected for a blood gas test. #9, “Navy Brass,” was scratched for being ineligible under, Eligibility rules - house rule #3. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 11 - 3 - 8.”**
