Approved scratches for today, veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative

For Tuesday, June 12, 2012 at the request of trainer Mr. Vazquez, Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, will collect twelve (12) samples for steroid testing. The cost of these samples will be paid by trainer Vazquez.

For the fourth race today we requested Commission Inspector Mr. Francis Swift to proceed to the racing surface, at the quarter mile chute to investigate a groom for trainer Bobbie McAlister who had fallen on the track. The ambulance crew for A-1 was on the scene, loaded the groom John Tatro into the ambulance to be transported off the racing surface. Mr. Swift called us later stating that Mr. Tatro was tested for alcohol and the results indicated that he was inebriated, with a test result of .44 which is well over the legal limit of .05. Mr. Tatro will be sent a hearing notice for this violation.
