SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:47 pm. OFF TIME – 1:50 pm. #1, “Embezzle (GB),” was a vet scratch. The rider on the #8, “Pounce Into Spring,” Nicolas Milford was changed to Yamil Rosario. No double jocks mount. #8, “Pounce Into Spring,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 2 - 6 - 4.”**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:19 pm. OFF TIME – 2:20 pm. #1, “Skip to the North,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #6, “Money For Love,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 – 1a - 4 - 6.”**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:51 pm. OFF TIME – 2:52 pm. The rider on the #8, “Single Malt Mac,” Javier Santiago was changed to Jeremy Rose. No double jocks mount. #5, “Bluegrass Chat,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 8 - 7.”**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:22 pm. OFF TIME – 3:22 pm. #1, “Sting Boy,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. The rider on the #2, “Great Magic,” broke on the horses’ mouth, breaking very slow. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 3 - 7 - 4.”**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:55 pm. OFF TIME – 3:57 pm. #2, “Kawiye,” was scratched as a main track only. #8, “Calliope,” was a vet scratch. #12, “Who Plays Brahms,” was scratched as an alternate. #1a, “Over Spiced,” was scratched as an alternate. The rider on the #11, “Reel Victory,” Javier Santiago was changed to Jeremy Rose. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 11 - 1 - 3.”** **HOLD AND CLAIM OF FOUL -** By the #3, “Laynee’s Moose,” Alex Cintron, against the #9, “Lady Raven,” Ricardo Santana Jr. for coming in at the point of the first turn, causing him to check his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, it looked to us as though the #9 was running straight, but the room for the #3 was getting less as the point of the turn was coming up. No action was taken.

SEVENTH RACE – “THE OBEAH STAKES (Grade III)” - POST TIME – 4:28 pm. OFF TIME – 4:30 pm. #2, “Pachattack,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. All horses were pre-race blood gas tested for this race. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 3 - 4.”**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:57 pm. OFF TIME – 4:58 pm. The rider on the #1, “Doc Holiday,” Robert Paz was changed to Alex Cintron as Mr. Paz is riding the other part of the same owner entry. No double jocks mount. #2, “A F Big Red,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 – 1a – 1 -5.”**
