Approved scratches for today, filed ambulance transport reports from management, veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative

The Stewards have issued Veterinarian Luis Benitez a penalty of a fifteen hundred \$1,500 dollar fine, for issuing a health certificate without examining the horses, under the Racing Commission rule 10.5. Health Certificate Required; which reads – “Licensee, within its discretion, may require a health certificate from an accredited, practicing veterinarian of any horse stabled or to be stabled on its grounds.”

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 pm. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #5, “Help Me Jeebis,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **INQUIRY IN STRETCH** - Hold and claim of foul by the #2, “Pleasant Hymn,” Jose Caraballo against the #4, “Orange’s Lil Sis,” Yomar Orlando Ortiz for coming in and shutting him off in the stretch. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, it looked to us as though when the rider of the #4 came over in front of the #2, the rider of the #2 had to take up sharply to avoid clipping heels. Subsequently, the #4 was disqualified from first and placed second behind the #2 who was moved up from second to first. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 4 - 8 - 1.”**
Starters -7.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:46 pm. OFF TIME – 1:48 pm. The rider on the #1, “Mayne Island,” Able Castellano Jr. was changed to Daniel Centeno as Mr. Castellano is riding the other part of the same-owner entry. #6, “Atlantis Moon,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 – 1a - 2 - 3.”** **Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:14 pm. OFF TIME – 2:16 pm. #5, “Notable Player,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 7 - 1 - 2.”** **Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 pm. OFF TIME – 2:45 pm. #2, “Zarroc,” and #4, “Worthy Wager,” were vet scratches. #3, “Sting Boy,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #7, “Silver Prado,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interest. #8, “Quarto,” Daniel Centeno, lost his right stirrup when the horse hit the left side of the gate when starting. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 5**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 pm. OFF TIME – 3:17 pm. #1, “Bishamon,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 8**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:44 pm. OFF TIME – 3:49 pm. #6, “Cactus Angel,” was pulled up at the seven-eighths pole after the race. Associate Commission Veterinarian Kathleen Picciano examined the horse, and placed a brace on the right front leg for transport. Due to the injury of the #6, “Cactus Angel,” it was taken off the racing surface and returned to the barn via horse ambulance. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 11**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:18 pm. OFF TIME – 4:19 pm. #5, “Tyrana,” was scratched as the horse could not be loaded on the van. #6, “Kinginthecity,” was scratched as the horse was placed on the veterinarians list. #2, “Merryland Moon,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interest. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 7 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 5**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:48 pm. OFF TIME – 4:49 pm. #1a, “Grilla,” and #2, “Butch Cassidy LZP,” were scratched as part of same-owner entries. #6, “Born to Boogie MC,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2b - 6 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:15 pm. OFF TIME – 5:16 pm. The rider on the #1a, “Uncorked,” Robert Paz, was changed to Alex Cintron, as Mr. Paz is riding the other part of the same-owner entry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 9**
