Equine Forensic Drug Testing

We received test clearances from Dalare Associates for Saturday, June 16, and Sunday, June 17, 2012, all tests were clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 pm. OFF TIME – 1:16 pm. The rider on the #6, “Delightful,” Brain Pedroza was changed to Able Mariano. Double jocks mount will be charged. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 pm. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:12 pm. OFF TIME – 2:13 p.m. #1, “Rock ‘n Roll Gal,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:40 pm. OFF TIME – 2:40 p.m. #1, “Sarbanes,” #2, “Tempt Me Alex,” #4, “Fuhr Town,” #6, “Art Class,” and #8, “Gottalovethedrake,” were scratched as this race is off the turf - #3, “I’m Not Who I Was,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Exacta, Superfecta, Place, and Show wagering for this race as we were below four betting interests. The #3, “I’m Not Who I Was,” did not finish the race, as the saddle had slipped forward and the horse was being pulled up down the stretch. The horse was assisted to the finish line by the outrider. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7.” Starters - 3**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:09 pm. OFF TIME – 3:10 p.m. #1, “Mine for Love,” and #2, “Tripp O Steel,” were scratched as part of same-owner entries. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 – 2b – 3 - 4.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:39 pm. OFF TIME – 3:41 p.m. #3, “Brand New Moves,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Saint Abe,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #4, “Sorry No Refunds,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #4, “Sorry No Refunds,” requested a one-hundred-seventy-five dollar (\$175.00) all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 6**

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF – The distance for this race was changed from seven and one half furlongs on the turf, to one mile on the dirt. **POST TIME – 4:11 pm. EIGHTH RACE – “THE SWEET AND SASSY STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:46 pm. #1, “Afleet Lass,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. #5, “Bold Affair,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 4**

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:16 pm. OFF TIME – 5:19 p.m. #1, “Tropical Deputy,” was scratched by the Stewards, as the horse got loose in the post parade and ran off three quarters of a mile before being caught by the outriders. #8, “J Double F,” was a late scratch by the Stewards, upon recommendation of Associate Commission Veterinarian Kathy Picciano, who reported that the horse was not warming up well. #2, “Cheswick,” was claimed by Kenneth Ivy – Jonas Gibson. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 7 - 5.” Starters - 6**
