We held a hearing this morning for Groom Sara Miller, concerning the issue of disabling, and blocking access to the fire alarm control panel in her doom room. As a result of the testimony presented at the hearing, Ms. Miller will be fined the sum of two-hundred-fifty dollars (\$250.00) for a fire safety violation.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 pm. OFF TIME – 1:16 pm.** #5, “Splash Landing,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Savannah Man,” was selected for a Stewards special test. **INQUIRY AT THE CLUBHOUSE TURN –** Hold and claim of foul by the #3, Della Notte,” Jonathan Joyce, against the #4, “Yes Papi Yes,” Daniel Centeno, for coming in and causing him to have to check his horse in the clubhouse turn. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, it looks like the #4 comes in slightly in the turn causing the #3 to steady his horse for half a stride. We could see no reason for a disqualification in this matter. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 3 - 2.” Starters - 7**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 pm. OFF TIME – 1:46 pm.** After a two-way shake, #1, “Endymion,” was claimed by Timothy Ritchey – Owner Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 7**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 pm. OFF TIME – 2:16 pm.** #4, “Lost Soul,” was a late scratch by the Stewards, upon recommendation of Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner who reported that the horse was not warming up well. **INQUIRY AT START –** It looked like the #5, “Mason’s Hope,” Daniel Centeno took a step back just as the starter started the race, breaking slow. After the finish, we spoke with starter, Glenn Menarde who confirmed that the horse took a step backwards prior to the start. We also talked to jockey Mr. Centeno, who also related that the horse had taken a step back just as the starter started the race. Consequently, no action was taken. We had a twelve minute tote delay in making this race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 5**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:48 pm. OFF TIME – 2:49 pm.** The rider on the #3, “Alaskan Dawn,” Brian Pedroza was changed to Yamil Rosario. No double jocks mount. #9, “Hornets Nest,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 8**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:18 pm. OFF TIME – 3:20 pm.** The rider on the #1a, “Calcutta Cat,” Oliver Castillo was changed to Jonathan Joyce, as Mr. Castillo is riding the other part of the same owner entry. The rider on the #4, “Causeyouoweme,” Brian Pedroza was changed to Able Mariano. No double jocks mount. #7, “On the Go,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “On The Go,” was claimed by MGRT Ventures LLC – Timothy Ritchey. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 8**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:47 pm. OFF TIME – 3:48 pm.** #1, “Flying Posse,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #2b, “Conflicting Report,” and #3, “He Belongs,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #4, “Mass Destruction,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Bellissima Luna,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 8 - 6.” Starters - 6**

**SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:17 pm. OFF TIME – 4:19 pm.** The rider on the #3, “Theatricality,” Brian Pedroza was changed to Yamil Rosario. No double jocks mount. The rider on the #6, “My One Only,” Luis Belmonte was changed to Able Mariano. No double jocks mount. #5, “Polonez,” was a vet scratch. #11, “Gadget,” and #12, “Embracing Hearts,” were scratched as alternates. #3, “Theatricality,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 10 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 9**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:47 pm. OFF TIME – 4:49 pm.** #1, “My Charming Clyde,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “It’s Never To Late,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Sneak a Cold Treat,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 – 1a - 4 - 9.” Starters - 7**
