Equine Forensic Drug Testing

On Tuesday, June 26, 2012, Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, performed out of competition sampling on five horses for five different trainers, per order of the Stewards.

Two Jockeys and Two Valets were randomly selected today for testing. All four tests were negative.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 4 - 8.” Starters - 8

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #1, “Ten Past Ten,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #4, “Stolz,” was a vet scratch. ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1a - 5 - 3.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:15 p.m. #1, “Fragancia,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Fragancia,” was a late scratch by the Stewards, upon recommendation of Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters who reported that the horse was not warming up well. After a two way shake #6, “Kawiye,” was claimed by Danny Limongelli – Hugh McMahan. ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 8 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 7

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. #1, “Alicantino,” was scratched by the racing office. #10, “Jerry N’ Elvis,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Jango,” and #12, “Maharani Ursula,” were scratched as main-track only. The rider on the #9, “Coturnix,” Luis Garcia was changed to Jeremy Rose, as Mr. Garcia is riding the horse that drew in off the alternate list. No double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 11 - 4 - 13.” Starters - 9**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:46 pm. OFF TIME – 3:46 pm. #3, “Flying Trey,” and #7, “Bellagio,” were vet scratches. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 8 - 6 - 1.” Starters – 6**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. #2, “Pretty Miss Tripi,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Wabash Moon,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 1 - 4.” Starters – 5**

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:55 p.m. #7, “My Name is Ralphie,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Next Level,” and #6, “Little Pinkie,” were scratched as main-track only. #4, “Nokaze,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2, “Bourbonstreetgirl,” was a late scratch by the Stewards, upon recommendation of Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, who reported that the horse had injured its right front leg when she flipped in the starting gate. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 5 - 4 - 8.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:22 p.m. #6, “Elegant Dancer MHF,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 7**
