Approved scratches for today, filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Chief State Steward Jack Houghton Jr. and Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters met with Executive Director of Racing John Mooney at 11:45 a.m. today to discuss the possible cancellation of the racing card for Saturday June 30, 2012.

Following the meeting and checking weather reports, Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters recommended that live racing be cancelled on Saturday, June 30, 2012 due to the extreme heat that is expected in our area. The national weather service has predicted temperatures above 99 degrees with a heat index in excess of 108. "Racing in such weather would potentially place the health of the horses and riders at risk" according to Dr. Peters.

Racing is expected to resume on Monday July 2, 2010

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #5, "Maharani Ursula," was selected for a blood gas test. #3, "Front Row Yo," was claimed by The Elkstone Group LLC – Thomas Iannotti IV. **ORDER OF FINISH – "3 - 5 - 6 - 2." Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. The rider on the #2, "Alisa's Engineer," Omar Hernandez was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr. No double jocks mount. #3, "Revelator," who was ridden by Joe Rocco Jr. was eased, pulling up after the race. "Revelator," was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen Picciano, who diagnosed the horse's condition as being sore. Dr. Picciano requested the horse ambulance transport and return the horse to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – "5 - 6 - 1 - 4." Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. The rider on the #5, “Serious Attitude,” Juan Molina Jr. was changed to Oliver Castillo. No double jocks mount. #8, “Scip Too Much,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Calling for Snow,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2, “Poppy’s Honor,” ridden by Osvaldo Vargas, broke through the starting gate prior to the start, was caught by the outriders, returned to the gate and examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Kathy Picciano who verified the horse was ok to race. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #1, “Druid Dancer,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 7**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #2, “Silver Slugger,” was selected for a blood gas test. #5, “Pot of Gold,” was scratched by the Stewards following an investigation conducted by Commission investigators. Investigation disclosed that the horse was treated by its trainer, Mr. Jorge Navarro with “Lyte Now” electrolyte paste today at approximately 11:15 a.m. which is within twenty-four hours of post time and a violation of rule 15.1.1.2. Mr. Navarro will be issued a hearing notice for this violation. #6, “Bubbling Springs,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 5**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. #1, “Mr. Mirage,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 6**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. The rider on the #2, “Sharp Numbers,” Jeremy Rose was changed to Alex Cintron, as Mr. Rose hurt his ankle on the starting gate in the prior race. No double jocks mount. #8, “Mega Boom,” was scratched by the trainer. #9, “Dickie Wonderboy,” was a vet scratch. #10, “Silver Prado,” and #12, “Thatleaveamark,” were scratched as a main-track only. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH –** The #11, “Maximoso,” Victor Rodriguez came out in front of the #3, “Prince Noirdown,” ridden by Julian Pimentel in the stretch, causing the #3, “Prince Noirdown,” to clip heels and stumble losing the jockey. After reviewing the films of the race, the #11, “Maximoso,” was disqualified from third and placed last for this infraction. Jockey Julian Pimentel was transported to the hospital to be evaluated. Hold and claim of foul by the Trainer of the #14, “Barbaro’s Revenge,” Peter Walder against the #13, “Going to Market,” Javier Santiago for coming out and bumping his horse first jump out of the gate. After reviewing the films of the race, the #13 does break out into the #14 but this was the first jump out of the gate. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “13 - 6 - 14 - 4.” Starters - 10**

EIGHTH RACE – “THE CAPE HENLOPEN OVERNIGHT STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:51 p.m. #3, “Eldaafer,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. The rider on the #2, “Sharp Numbers,” Jeremy Rose was changed to Able Castellano Jr.; No double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:20 pm. OFF TIME – 5:21 p.m. The #5, “The Admiral’s flank,” was eased at the half-mile pole and did not finish. After being examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen Picciano, the horse walked off the racing surface under its own power. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 8**
