At the movies today for the seventh race on Thursday, June 28, 2012 for apprentice jockey Victor Rodriguez and jockey Julian Pimentel. Mr. Rodriguez will receive a fifteen-day (15) suspension for extremely careless riding in the stretch.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #2, “On The Board,” was claimed by Jason Egan & Joan Everett – Jason Egan. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. INQUIRY FIRST TURN – The rider on #6, “Whata Soandso,” Abel Castellano Jr., came off the horse in the first turn. After reviewing the films and talking to the rider it looked like the horse was getting out going into the first turn, clipping heels with the #3, “More Than Lucky,” ridden by Alex Canchari. No action was taken. Mr. Castellano Jr. was reported to be OK by first aid EMT Matt Conegys, and will continue riding after he sits out one race. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 5 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 9**

No double jocks mount. #4, “Mala Mala Cat,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #6, “Bold Cat,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Wiseman’s Bluff,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3, “Wiseman’s Bluff,” was claimed by John Fanelli – Juan Vazquez. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 8 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. The rider on the #1, “Woodburner,” Julian Pimentel was changed to Javier Santiago. No double jocks mount. #2, “Mendenhall,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 8 - 6.” Starters - 7**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. The rider on the #8, “Lacrosse Moon,” Robert Paz was changed to Oliver Castillo. Double jocks mount will be charged. The rider on the #13, “Gambine Road,” Manuel Chaves was changed to Wesley Ho. No double jocks mount. #1, “Sutton Road,” and #5, “A Single Man,” were scratched as main-track only. #9, “Wildlee Certain,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “12 - 6 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 10**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:50 p.m. #4, “Monster Sleeping,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – ARABAINS - POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:16 p.m. #1, “Burnin Rubber,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Valiant Boy SBFAR,” was selected for a blood gas test. **Hold and Claim of foul by the #3,** “Valiant Boy SBFAR,” Santos Chavez against the #1a, “Butch Cassidy LZP,” for coming out in front of him in the stretch. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race it looked to us as though the #1a does come out in the stretch but was clear of the #3 when doing so. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 3 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 7**
