Approved scratches for today, reviewed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, June 27, and Thursday, June 28, 2012, which were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #4, “Sharp Harbour,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 7 - 8.” Starters - 9**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:42 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. The rider on the #4, “Saving Elena,” scheduled to be ridden by Anthony Mawing was changed to Abel Castellano Jr. No double jocks mount. The #6, “Hollywood Corner,” was claimed by Ray Greenway – Deborah Simpson. We had a slight delay in the start of this race as the #6, “Hollywood Corner,” flipped in the gate. “Hollywood Corner,” was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Kathleen Picciano who approved the horse to run. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 4 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - *The horses were ordered to go straight to the starting gate from the paddock starting this race due to the heat.* **POST TIME – 2:12 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:15 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE TOP OF STRETCH –** Hold and claim of foul by the #4, “Direct Dial.” Abel Castellano Jr. against the #5, “Youcancountonme,” Luis Garcia for coming out at the top of the stretch and bumping his horse. This caused Castellano’s mount to stumble and unset him from the saddle. Following the race, the riders were interviewed and after a review of the films of the race, it looked to us as though the #5 comes out at the top of the stretch bumping the #4 causing him to stumble and lose the rider. Subsequently, the #5, “Youcancountonme,” was disqualified from third and placed last for this infraction. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 8**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:42 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:44 p.m. #1, “Silverest,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 1a - 8 - 7.” Starters - 10**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:09 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:11 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 7 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 8

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:36 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:39 p.m. #2, “Vanquisher,” was scratched by the racing office. #7, “Parody,” was scratched as a main-track only. #8, “Roadhog,” was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 7

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:06 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:08 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 8

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:36 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:39 p.m. The rider on the #7, “Dancinwithnoshuz,” Manuel Chaves was changed to Yamil Rosario. No double jocks mount. The rider on the #8, “Avie Atrass,” Carlos Esquilin was changed to Victor Rodriguez. No double jocks mount #12, “Emily’s Spirit,” was scratched by the trainer. #13, “Girlsruletheworld,” was scratched as an alternate. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 11 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 12**

NINTH RACE – “THE WHITE CLAY CREEK OVERNIGHT STAKES” - POST TIME – 5:03 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:07 p.m. The rider on the #10, “Walkin in a Shadow,” Elvis Trujillo was changed to Victor Santiago. No double jocks mount. #1, “Trish’s Wish,” #2, “Stormy Adventure,” #3, “Dixieland Silk,” #5, “My Sonata,” and #8, “Luvmealldayindyusa,” were scratched as this is a stakes race. #10, “Walkin in a Shadow,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 10 - 7 - 9.” Starters - 5**

TENTH RACE – ARABIANS – “THE DR. SAM HARRISON JUVENILE ARABIAN FILLY STAKES” - POST TIME – 5:33 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:34 p.m. The rider on the #1, “My Rich Sister,” Oliver Castillo was changed to Esteban Unsihuay as Mr. Castillo is riding the other part of the same-owner entry. #2b, “C Louise,” was scratched as part of same-owner entry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 3 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 7**
