Approved scratches for today, reviewed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative

Today we received confirmation of all three split sample positives that were sent to Iowa State University, for trainer Mr. Juan Vazquez.

All three Stewards met with Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters and Executive Director of Racing John Mooney at 10:45 a.m. today to discuss the possibility of canceling the racing card scheduled for Saturday, July 7, 2012. Dr. Peters recommended that live racing be cancelled on Saturday, July 7, 2012 due to the extreme heat that is expected in our area. The National Weather Service has predicted temperatures above 100 degrees and a heat index of 109. "Racing in such weather would potentially place the health of the horses and riders at risk" according to Dr. Peters.

Racing is expected to resume on Monday July 9, 2012 when temperatures are expected to be in the high 80's.

The post parades for today will be shortened, due to high temperatures.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #2, "Don't Push It,"
was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – "3 - 1 - 7 - 4." Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:41 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:43 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – "6 - 3 - 2 - 1." Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:07 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:09 p.m. The correct name for the rider on the #6, “Cabaret Cowboy,” was noted as Felix Reyes and not Felix Ferrer. #2, “Ashtonofun,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Rich Hero,” was claimed by Trigger Racing – Edward Lotruglio. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 6 - 4.” Starters – 7**

The official Equibase chart incorrectly listed “Felix Ferrer” as the rider of the #6, “CABARET COWBOY.” Equibase will be contacted so they can correct the official chart.

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:34 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:35 p.m. #4, “Holy Mo,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 9**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:02 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:04 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:27 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:30 p.m. #4, “Miss Ravallo,” was scratched by the trainer due to the heat. #5, “Falcon’s Flight,” and #10, “Pipers Punch,” were vet scratches. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 3 - 1 - 7.” Starters - 7**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:54 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:56 p.m. #5, “Parseghian,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 8**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:27 p.m. The #7, “Rubble Rouser,” was acting up in the gate, was taken out of the gate, examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner who said the horse was ok to run. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 3 - 8 - 4.” Starters – 10.**

Following the race, the #5, “Rebecca Mia,” unseated its rider, Alex Canchari while pulling up. The horse was subsequently caught by the outriders. Jockey Canchari was examined by EMT Matt Conegys, who said Mr. Canchari complained about wrist pain, but signed a refusal of treatment form.

TENTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:18 p.m. #1, “Burnin Rubber,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Tiki Barber,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 – 1a - 5 - 7.” Starters - 8**
