Approved scratches for today, veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing

Received post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Monday, July 2, 2012, which were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #5, “Icelandic Blast,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Queen Bee Teresa,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:42 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:43 p.m. The rider on the #1a, “Wildcat Code,” Hugo Sanchez was changed to Yomar Ortiz. No double jocks mount. #3, “Royale Harbor,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 2 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:08 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:09 p.m. The rider on the #5, “Trappist Monk,” Hugo Sanchez was changed to Alex Batista. No double jocks mount. #7, “Mendenhall,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #5, “Trappist Monk,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:34 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:35 p.m. #9, “Lobo Del Norte,” #10, “Urban Jungle,” and #12, “Alisa’s Engineer,” were scratched as alternates. #1, “Thatlleveaveamark,” #1a, “Dublin Da’bet,” and #11, “Garp,” were scratched as main track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:04 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:09 p.m. #1, “Proud Daddy,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Brad,” was selected for a blood gas test. We experienced a twenty-six (26) minute tote delay in making this race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:34 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:36 p.m. The rider on the #5, “Nico the Champ,” Hugo Sanchez was changed to Yomar Ortiz. No double jocks mount. The #6, “Bunker Hill,” flipped in the starting gate and was backed out to allow Associate Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen Picciano to conduct an examination. Following examination by Dr. Picciano, she recommended that the horse was fit to race. The #8, “Chuckie’s Honor,” ridden by Juan Molina, was pulled up during the race and eased at the quarter pole. “Chuckie’s Honor,” was examined by Dr. Picciano who diagnosed that the horse had sustained an injury to its tendon. As a precaution to minimize stress, “Chuckie’s Honor” was transported via horse ambulance to its barn. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:02 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:03 p.m. #8, “Lucky Lady Lawyer,” and #10, “Smart Cash,” were scratched as main-track only. #11, “Slam Bid,” was scratched as an alternate. #4, “Something Shiny,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Something Shiny,” ridden by Jeremy Rose, was eased past the finish line. We called Mr. Rose who stated that the horse was having a breathing problem. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 6 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 8**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:29 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:32 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 6

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:57 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:58 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 8

TENTH RACE – ARABIANS – “THE ALEC COURTELIS ARABIAN JUVENILE STAKES” - POST TIME – 5:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:23 p.m. #1, “Djent,” and #2b, “Mahra T,” were scratched as part of same-owner entries. #6, “Last American Man BVF,” was scratched as this is a stake race. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 – 1a - 4 - 7.” Starters - 6**
