was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #6, “Out To Flank You,” was a vet scratch. #3,
“Shirts and Shoes,” was scratched by the Stewards, due to the horse unseating its rider, Javier
Santiago while leaving the paddock. Furthermore, the horse in question ran loose on the
track for approximately 5/8ths of a mile before being caught by the starting gate crew.

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF – “THE WALKING IN DA SUN OVERNIGHT STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:34 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:38 p.m. #3, “Masquerade,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. While in the paddock, the #8, “Charged Cotton,” flipped in its stall injuring itself. The horse was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen Picciano, who determined that it had been injured.
