**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m.** The rider on the #3, “Alex’s Vision,” Alex Canchari, was changed to Daniel Centeno. No double jocks mount. #1, “Peaceadaaction,” was selected for a blood gas test. #6, “Dancing Roman,” was claimed by Kryskaly Horseracing Inc – Julio Cartagena. **INQUIRY AT START - #6, Dancing Roman,”** Javier Santiago, dwelt at the start breaking well behind the field. After reviewing the films, the gate functioned properly with the assistant starter letting the horse loose but the horse just stood there, breaking very late. We talked to the rider Mr. Santiago and he agreed with the Stewards, stating that the horse just stood there when the doors opened. We also talked to the Starter, Glen Menarde, who also confirmed what we had observed. Mr. Menarde will be placing the horse on the “Starters List.” **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 2 - 4.”**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m.** The rider on the #6, “Mr. Commissioner,” Ricardo Chiappe, was changed to Daniel Centeno. No double jocks mount. #1, “A Fleet Spirit,” and #2, “Belgian Beer,” were vet scratches. #3, “Adam’s Nay,” who was ridden by Jose Caraballo, was eased at the quarter-pole. “Adam’s Nay,” was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, who diagnosed the horse’s condition as being off in the right front. Dr. Peters requested the horse ambulance transport and return the horse to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 5 - 4 - 9.” Starters - 7**
