We conducted a hearing this morning for jockey Abel Mariano who had tested positive for opiates on July 12, 2012. Mr. Mariano is suspended pending an evaluation and recommendation by Mr. G. Wesley Jones II, counselor for the backstretch employee assistance program.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Heckuva Ride,”
was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 8**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. The rider on the #1a, “Compass Rock,” Abel Castellano Jr., was changed to Daniel Centeno, as Mr. Castellano is riding the other part of the same-owner entry. The #5, “Lemon Juice,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #5, “Lemon Juice,” requested a one-hundred-seventy-five (\$175.00) dollar all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m. The rider on the #1, “Alisa’s Engineer,” Abel Mariano, was changed to Juan Molina. No double jocks mount. #6, “Ninth Client,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 8**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:50 p.m.
The rider on the #1, “Tactical Sting,” Osvaldo Vargas, was changed to Robert Paz. No double jocks mount. #4, “Skip to the North,” and #5, “Richie’s Rocket,” were scratched as main-track only. #10, “Ham and Ernie,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 8 - 2 - 9.” Starters - 9**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m. INQUIRY START -
#7, “Designer,” Daniel Centeno, stumbled at the start, losing its rider. Jockey Centeno was sent to first aid to be evaluated. EMT Bob Bates called the Stewards from first aid, stating that Mr. Centeno was evaluated, signing a refusal of treatment form. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 2 - 8.” Starters - 8**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:51 p.m. The rider on the #6, “Senor Quicke,” Daniel Centeno, was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr. Mr. Centeno was required by the Stewards to sit out this race for safety reasons before he could continue riding. #1, “Achilles Quest,” was a vet scratch. #5, “S S Skittles,” and #11, “Irunalatte,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #7, “Outbacker,” was scratched as a main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 4 - 9 - 3.” Starters - 7**

SEVENTH RACE – “THE OH SAY OVERNIGHT STAKES - POST TIME –4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:21 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 7

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:51 p.m. The rider on the #8, “Menifee Six,” Javier Santiago, was changed to Joe Rocco Jr. No double jocks mount. #1, “Chance and a Half,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Personal Edge,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Rare Lukey,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #8, “Menifee Six,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 – 1a - 8 - 4.” Starters - 8**

NINTH RACE – ON THE TURF – “THE ROBERT G. DICK MEMORIAL STAKES (Grade III)” - POST TIME – 5:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:22 p.m. The rider on the #8, “Senada,” Alex Cintron, was changed to Luis Garcia. No double jocks mount. All horses were blood gas tested. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 8**

TENTH RACE – “THE DELAWARE OAKS (Grade II) - POST TIME – 5:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:55 p.m. #1, “Singlet,” was scratched as part a same-owner entry. #4, “Morrow Cove,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. All horses were blood gas tested. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 5 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 5**

ELEVENTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 6:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 6:24 p.m.
The rider on the #1, “Doc Holliday,” Gregorio Rivera, was changed to Robert Paz, as Mr. Rivera is riding the other part of the same-owner entry. #1, “Doc Holliday,” with jockey Robert Paz, fell just past the finish line. The horse in question was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian, John Peters. Following examination, Dr. Peters reported that the horse appeared to be uninjured. As for the jockey, Robert Paz, he got up and walked to the ambulance, was examined by the EMT’s and appeared to be fine. Paz signed a waiver of treatment form. There was a nine minute tote delay in making this race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 3 – 1a.” Starters - 7**
