Approved scratches for today, reviewed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing

We received test clearances from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, July 11, and Thursday, July 12, 2012 which were all clear, with the exception of D-08046 which was positive for “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 13.8 micrograms per milliliter of plasma.

We requested Commission Inspector’s Mr. Francis Swift and Mr. Ramon Rodriguez to conduct a barn search this morning concerning the “PHENYLBUTAZONE,” positive. The barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer, Jamie Ness were inspected. Results of the search did not reveal any contraband, only a bottle of phenylbutazone powder which could be related to the positive tests.

Administrative

Two Jockeys and two Valets were randomly selected today for testing. All four tests were negative.

We held a hearing this morning for Jockey Agent, Mark Mace for allegedly giving a call to Trainer, Greg Griffith, and not honoring that call. After hearing all the testimony from the parties, it was our determination that there was no call issued. No action was taken.

We held a hearing this morning for Exercise Boy, Bradley Hedges II, concerning a near-miss collision on the race track during training hours. Mr. Hedges will be back before the Stewards on Tuesday, July 24, 2012, with the Trainer that he works for before a determination is made in this matter.

The Stewards have issued a decision on the three “Boldenone” positives for trainer Juan Vazquez. The penalty issued for the first positive test, concerning the horse “Es La Mia (ARG); Mr. Vazquez will be fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars he will also receive a seven (7) day suspension. In addition the horse “Es La Mia (ARG)” will be disqualified from all purse money.

The penalty issued for the second positive test, concerning the horse “Cat Weisel;” Mr. Vazquez will be fined the sum of one-thousand (\$1000.00) dollars and a fifteen (15) day suspension. The horse “Cat Weisel,” will be disqualified from all purse money.

The penalty issued for the third positive test concerning the horse “My Friend Dr. Nick;” Mr. Vazquez will be fined the sum of fifteen-hundred (\$1500.00) dollars and a thirty (30) day suspension. The horse “My Friend Dr. Nick” will be disqualified from all purse money.

Mr. Vazquez was furnished with information on his right to appeal along with appropriate paper work. Mr. Vazquez advised that he will get back to us on Monday, July 23, to let us know his decision.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. The rider on the #1, “Final Hope,” Oliver Castillo, was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr. as Mr. Castillo is riding the other part of the same-owner entry; no double jocks mount. #4, “Bethany Breeze,” and “Maxie’s Nimblefeet,” were vet scratches. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 3 – 1a.” Starters - 5**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. The rider on the #6, “Geraldine’s thunder,” Alex Cintron, was changed to Yamil Rosario; no double jocks mount. Note: Jockey Cintron was injured at Parx on Monday, July 16, 2012. #1a, “Pleasant Hymn,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Prime Mistress,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #3, “Amadorable,” was selected for a blood gas test. A thunder storm started just after this race was official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 0:00 p.m. *RACING WAS CANCELED FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE RACING CARD DUE TO HEAVY RAINS WHICH SHIFTED THE RACING SURFACE MATERIALS AND CAUSED THE TRACK TO BE UNEVEN. THE TRACK CREW HAD TO WAIT FOR THE WATER TO RUN OFF BEFORE FLOATING AND HARROWING TO DRY THE MATERIALS TO EVEN THE SURFACE.*
