



# Daily Log Stewards Report Delaware Park

Approved scratches for today, reviewed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

### Equine Forensic Drug Testing

We received test clearances from Dalare Associates for Saturday, July 14, and Monday, July 16, 2012, which were all clear.

### Administrative

Associate Commission Veterinarian, Susan Botts is performing sample collection for pre-race blood-gas testing for the graded stake and other overnight races.

Note: Hearing held on Thursday, July 19, 2012 for Assistant Trainer/Exercise Boy Bradley Hedges II concerning a dangerous incident on the race track, resulted in a fine of two-hundred-fifty (\$250.00) dollars and a suspension from galloping and or ponying horses for thirty days. The suspension will run from July 22, through August 20, 2012, inclusive.

Based on probable cause, Bradley Hedges II was tested for drugs by Commission Inspector Francis Swift at the request by the Stewards. The first sample obtained from the subject was found to be adulterated as the temperature of the sample did not meet the level for an immediate sample. The 2<sup>nd</sup> sample from Hedges, observed by Inspector Swift met temperature standards. The 2<sup>nd</sup> sample tested positive for Marijuana and Cocaine. Hedges was summarily suspended for the positive and referred to the Backstretch Employee Assistance Program (BEAP) counselor, Wesley Jones. Mr. Hedges will have to be evaluated by Counselor Jones before being considered for reinstatement. The split sample in this matter was sent to LabCorp for confirmation. A report from the Medical Review Officer (MRO) will accompany the confirmatory letter.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:18 p.m.** The rider on the #3, “Smart Executive,” Julian Pimentel, was changed to Robert Paz, as Mr. Pimentel is riding at Colonial Downs; no double jocks mount. #1, “Drunken Love,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Shookstown Road,” was claimed by Glen Gaddy – Thomas Iannotti IV. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 6 – 1a.” Starters - 7**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:52 p.m.** The rider on the #3, “Vielsalm,” Julian Pimentel, was changed to Joe Rocco Jr.; no double jocks mount. #9, “Wishfulthinkin Gal,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #4, “Lost Resolve,” was scratched by the Stewards upon the advice of Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who said the horse was not warming up well. The #7, “Kisses for Love,” unseated its rider, Jeremy Rose during the post parade. Jockey Rose, was injured and remounted the horse after it was caught by the outriders. Association Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen Picciano examined the horse and determined that it was fit to race. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 5 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 8**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:21 p.m.** #1a, “Brassy Boy,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #8, “Sting Boy,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #9, “Grande Gayego,” was a vet scratch. After a four-way shake, #2, “Endymion,” was claimed by Reyes Segredo Family Stable – Alejandro Reyes. #7, “Battle Harbour,” was claimed by Timothy Richey Stable Inc. – Timothy Richey. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 7**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:51 p.m.** The rider on the #7, “Delightful Nicole,” Brian Pedroza, was changed to Yamil Rosario, as Mr. Pedroza apparently hurt his back in the second race, taking off the rest of the day after being checked by EMT Matt Conegys at first aid; no double jocks mount. #4, “Tapit to Me,” and #6, “Hip Hop Girl,” were vet scratches. #2, “Hip Notic,” and #11, “Party Hardy,” were scratched as main track only. #7, “Delightful Nicole,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 9 - 12.” Starters - 9**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:19 p.m.** The rider on the #2, “Prime Mistress,” Julian Pimentel, was changed to Christopher Ho; no double jocks mount. #6, “Pumpidu,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 8 - 3.” Starters - 8**

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m.** The rider on the #3, “Hi Ho Bambino,” Julian Pimentel, was changed to Oliver Castillo; no double jocks mount. #1, “Tizsilk,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT START** – The #5, “Dinner in Odem,” threw his head to the side and then went up in the air just as the race started. We talked to the jockey Daniel Centeno who related that his horse threw his head and reared-up at the start, and confirmed that the assistant starter let the horse loose as the race started. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 9 - 10.” Starters - 11**

**SEVENTH RACE – “THE DASHING BEAUTY OVERNIGHT STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m.** The rider on the #2, “Moonlit Malibu,” Julian Pimentel, was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #5, “Romantic Cueve,” Eric Camacho, was changed to Jeremy Rose; no double jocks mount. #3, “Celtic Chant,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 5 - 6.”**  
**Starters – 8**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m.** The rider on the #7, “Corinthian Quest,” Julian Pimentel, was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. #8, “Broad Moon,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 7 - 1.”** **Starters - 7**

**NINTH RACE – ON THE TURF - “THE SUSSEX STAKES” - POST TIME – 5:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:19 p.m.** #2, “Marilyn’s Guy,” and #6, “Lentenor,” were scratched as this is a stakes race. All horse were pre-race blood gas tested. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 4 - 7.”** **Starters - 7**

**TENTH RACE – “THE DELAWARE HANDICAP (Grade II) - POST TIME – 5:51 pm. OFF TIME – 5:55 pm.** All horse were pre-race blood gas tested. Following the race, jockey, Jeremy Rose was unseated while pulling up the #7 horse, “Love and Pride” due to his stirrup breaking. Mr. Rose went to first aid to be examined. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 6 - 7.”** **Starters – 7**

**ELEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 6:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 6:35 p.m.** The rider on the #4, “Surprisedtoseeme,” Brian Pedroza, was changed to Santos Chavez; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #5, “Dylan the Deputy,” Daniel Centeno, was changed to Jorge Rodriguez; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #7, “Fouty Four Loco,” Alex Canchari, was changed to Juan Torres; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #10, “Copper Tiger,” Oliver Castillo, was changed to Juan Molina Jr.; no double jocks mount. The #4, “Surprisedtoseeme,” and the #7, “Forty Four Loco,” were late scratches, as riders Santos Chavez, and Juan Torres refused to ride their mounts due to the way they were warming up. No other riders were available to substitute for Chavez and Torres. The #3, “Whowhathow,” was scratched by the Stewards upon the advice of Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who said the horse had broken a tooth because bit on the bridle was on backwards and upside down. Prior to the start, the #8, “Mason,” broke through the gate and unseated its rider, Javier Santiago. The horse was caught by the outriders approximately one hundred yards from gate. “Mason” was returned to the starting gate where it was examined by Dr. Teichner advising in her opinion, the horse was fit to race. Jockey Santiago advised that he was uninjured and following evaluation by the EMT’s, was approved to ride. The #8 started in the race without further incident. **“ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 9 - 10 - 5.”** **Starters - 8**

**TWELFTH RACE – ARABIANS – “THE VALOUR FARMS ARABIAN STAKES (Grade II)” - POST TIME – 7:04 p.m. OFF TIME – 7:04 p.m.** The rider on the #2b, “Ms Dixie,” Gregorio Rivera, was changed to Jorge Rodriguez, as Mr. Rivera is riding the other part of the same-owner entry; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 – 1a - 4 – 1 - 5.” Starters - 7**
