Approved scratches for today, reviewed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Trainer Juan Vazquez came in this morning and filed appeals for the three rulings that were issued against him for the three post race positive test findings of “boldenone.” The first appeal is for the horse “Es La Mia (ARG)” who had finished first in the third race on Saturday, May 12, 2012. The second appeal is for the horse “Cat Wiesel,” who finished first in the second race on Thursday, May 24, 2012. The third appeal is for the horse “My Friend Dr. Nick” who finished first in the third race on Thursday, May 24, 2012. *Appeal paperwork was accepted and a hearing date of September 12, 2012 was set.*
