Approved scratches for today, filed ambulance transport reports from management, reviewed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing

We received test clearances from Dalare Associates for Saturday, July 21, and Monday, July 23, 2012 which were clear with the exception of D-06991 which was positive for “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 5.22 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. We requested Commission Inspectors Swift and Rodriguez to conduct a barn search this morning concerning the phenylbutazone positive. The barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer, Heather Hollahan were inspected. Results of the inspection did not reveal any contraband. A bottle of phenylbutazone pills was discovered which could be related to the positive test.

Administrative

Two jockeys were randomly selected today for testing. Both tests were negative.

A search of the jockey's room was conducted this morning, for illegal equipment by Commission Inspectors Swift, Rodriguez, and Steward, Fritz Burkhardt. The only illegal equipment found was a safety vest that was in violation of Commission standards, and was confiscated.

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:21 p.m. #1a, “Hannah’s Princess,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Next Level,” #4, “Win Picture,” and #11, “Cape Girl,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #7, “Well Equipped,” was vet scratch. #6, “Broad Contour,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 9 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:51 p.m. INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START – Hold and claim of foul by the #4, “Brooks Lass,” Javier Santiago, against the #7, “Wakina,” Martin Solis for coming in shortly after the start causing him to steady his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, it looked to us as though the #7 was marginally clear of the #4 when drifting in. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 7**

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:23 p.m. #6, “Snow Flurry,” was scratched as a main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 1 - 7.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m. The rider on the #1, “Distinctive Alibi,” Javier Santiago, was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr.; no double jocks mount. #2, “Tropical Deputy,” was scratched by the trainer. #6, “Flipion,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 9 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 8**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:24 p.m. The rider on the #10, “Etar,” Luis Garcia, was changed to Abel Castellano Jr.; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #12, “More Moetion,” Oliver Castillo, was changed to Brian Pedroza; no double jocks mount. #9, “Kingofthehighcees,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Northern Evader,” #13, “I’m Tapped Out,” and #14, “Broomer,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 12 - 6.” Starters - 10**

EIGHTH RACE – “THE STONEWALL FARM OCALA HOCKESSIN OVERNIGHT STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:53 p.m. The rider on the #7, “Escort,” Yamil Rosario, was changed to Abel Castellano Jr.; no double jocks mount. #1, “Homeboykris,” #3, “J J’s Lucky Train,” #4, “Delaunay,” and #8, “Tommy’s Memory,” were scratched as this is a stakes race. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **INQUIRY IN STETCH –** Hold and claim of foul by the #2, “Picko’s Pride,” Ricardo Santana Jr., against the #6, “Bet the Power,” Joseph Rocco Jr. for coming out and intimidating his horse causing him to check and go to the inside. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, it looked to us like the #6, comes way out down the stretch very quickly, causing intimidation of the #2 who took up and went to the inside. The #6 was disqualified from first and placed second, behind the #2 who was moved up from second and placed first. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 – 1a - 5.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:21 p.m. #2, “Miss Paradise,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #6, “Extra Cool,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 5 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 7**
