Approved scratches for today, reviewed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 pm. OFF TIME – 1:16 pm. ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 6 - 5.” Starters - 7

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:42 pm. OFF TIME – 1:45 pm. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 8 - 6.” Starters - 8

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:12 pm. OFF TIME – 2:13 pm. The rider on the #4, “Foolish Comment,” Alex Cintron, was changed to Julian Pimentel; no double jocks mount. #5, “Winsome Willie,” was scratched by the trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 8 - 6.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:39 pm. OFF TIME – 2:40 pm. The rider on the #3, “Northern Evader,” Alex Cintron, was changed to Julian Pimentel; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 7**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:06 pm. OFF TIME – 3:07 pm. The rider on the #2b, “Wildcat Code,” Yomar Orlando Ortiz, was changed to Abel Castellano Jr., as Mr. Ortiz is riding the other part of the same-owner entry; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Whatsnottolike,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Harbor Fox,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Sing It Again,” was claimed by Mary Eppler Racing Stable Inc – Mary Eppler. #4, “Bluebird Quartet,” was claimed by Marion Smith – Kenny Smith. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 2b - 2 - 4.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:33 pm. OFF TIME – 3:36 pm. The rider on the #4, “Johar Beauty,” Jeremy Rose, was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #9, “Blue Geranium,” was a vet scratch. #8, “All Decked Out,” and #11, “Party Hardy,” were scratched as main-track only. #3, “Kind Hearted Woman,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 7 - 6.” Starters - 8**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:02 pm. OFF TIME – 4:03 pm. #1a, “Ten Past Ten,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Good Feng Shui,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Glib,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 8 - 1.”**
Starters - 7

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:29 pm. OFF TIME – 4:30 pm. The rider on the #3, “Kawiye,” Jeremy Rose, was changed to Forest Boyce; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #4, “Fragancia,” Angel Suarez, was changed to Carlos Esquilin; no double jocks mount. **INQUIRY IN DEEP STRETCH** – Hold and claim of foul by the trainer Jonas Gibson and the rider, Abel Castellano Jr. of the #6, “Little Pinkie,” against the #4, “Fragancia,” ridden by Carlos Esquilin for coming out and bumping him in the stretch. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race it looked to us as though the #1, “Next Level,” with rider Joshua Navarro comes out down the stretch forcing the #4 out, who brushed with the #6, right at the finish. As it looked like the #1 caused this progression along with it happening at the finish; no action was taken. #3, “Kawiye,” who was ridden by Forest Boyce was eased, pulling up after the race. “Kawiye,” was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen Picciano, who diagnosed the horse as being lame in its left hind. Dr. Picciano requested the horse ambulance transport and return the horse to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 – 1- 8.” Starters - 9**

NINTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 5:01 pm. OFF TIME – 5:02 pm. #8, “My Friend Dr. Joe,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Early Eddie,” #3, “Notable Player,” #9, “Quarto,” and #10, “Downhill Dale,” were scratched as main-track only. The #1, “Upper Afleet,” Joe Rocco Jr.; finished last well beaten. We talked to the rider Mr. Rocco Jr. who stated that the horse could not handle the yielding turf and kept stumbling. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 11 - 6.” Starters - 6**

TENTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:27 pm. OFF TIME – 5:28 pm. The rider on the #5, “Chiquita Rose,” Robert Paz, was changed to Gregorio Rivera; double jocks mount will be charged. #2, “Ovour the Rainbow,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2, “Ovour the Rainbow,” was claimed by Quarter Moon Ranch – Scott Powell. **INQUIRY IN STRETCH** – Hold and claim of foul by the #6, “Se Dici,” Victor Rodriguez against the #2, “Ovour the Rainbow,” ridden by Juan Torres for coming out bumping him in the stretch. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the #2 comes out down the stretch bumping the #6 and after the bump lost momentum. Consequently, the #2 was disqualified from first and placed second behind the #6 who was moved to first from second. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 6**
