Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

On this date, we received an appeal to a portion of Stewards ruling, 44-2012, from Trainer, Jamie Ness. Trainer Ness appealed the 7 day suspension for the Phenylbutazone positive for his horse, "SORRY NO REFUNDS:" while not contesting the \$500.00 fine or purse redistribution. Although Mr. Ness waived his right to a twenty-day notice, his appeal will be scheduled for the September 12, 2012 Commission meeting.

Trainer's Test

Horse owner, Ms. Cathy Denelsbeck received a passing score of 76% on the Trainer's test that she completed on July 31, 2012, Ms. Denelsbeck will be issued a certificate of accomplishment for her effort.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #4, "Clapifyoubelieve," was a vet scratch. #5, "Lyrical Rhythms," was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – "3 - 1 - 6 - 2." Starters - 5**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. The rider on the #2, "Whowhathow," Martin Solis, was changed to Carlos Esquilin; no double jocks mount. #1, "Risk On," and #7, "Mach Twelve," were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. The #6, "Cheswick," ridden by Alex Cintron, pulled up lame after the race and was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, who said the horse was lame in the right front. The horse ambulance was requested to transport the horse back to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – "3 - 6 - 4 - 5." Starters - 5**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #5, “Sue’s Sweet Sioux,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. #2, “Overlook,” #9, “Ciguaraya,” and #10, “Itsagiantcauseway,” were vet scratches. #1a, “Shanfield,” and #7, “Carrietta,” were scratched as main-track only. #4, “Nokaze,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 6- 4.” Starters - 6**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:15 p.m. #1, “Not for Money,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Yano,” and #7, “Rich Hero,” were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 – 1a - 5 - 6.” Starters - 5**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. #7, “Lil Escape Artist,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Silverest,” and #3, “Across the Track,” were scratched as main-track only. #11, “Embracing Hearts,” was claimed by Kryskaly Horse Racing Inc – Julio Cartagena. **ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 1 - 10 - 12.” Starters - 10**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 9

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - “THE THOMAS “TUCK’ GREENE MEMORIAL OVERNIGHT STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m. The rider on the #8, “Touring Hong Kong,” Jose Caraballo, was changed to Julian Pimentel; no double jocks mount. #5, “Brooks Secret,” and #6, “Atlantis Moon,” were scratched as this is a stakes race. **INQUIRY AT START - #8, “Touring Hong Kong,”** ridden by Julian Pimentel, reared up at the start breaking slow. After reviewing the films and talking to Julian Pimentel, he confirmed that his horse reared up as the race started and broke slowly. No action taken on the Stewards Inquiry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:16 p.m. The rider on the #1, “Sand Star AA,” Robert Paz, was changed to Juan Torres, as Mr. Paz is riding the other part of the same-owner entry; no double jocks mount. #2, “C Louise,” and #6, “Breaking Newz,” were vet scratches. #4, “A F Cheveyo,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 4 – 1a.” Starters - 6**
