Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed ambulance transport reports from management, veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

We received test clearances from Dalare Associates for Saturday, July 28, and Monday, July 30, 2012, which were all clear.

Administrative:

Two jockeys and two valets were randomly selected today for testing. All tests were negative.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. The rider on the #4, “Time Has Come,” Sheldon Russell, was changed to Abel Castellano Jr.; no double jocks mount. #5, “Giacovani,” was claimed by Nick Sanna Stables Inc – Michael Pino. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #6, “Rare Lukey,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Mister Dish,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m. #8, “Two of a Kind,” was scratched as a main track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 6 - 10.” Starters - 10**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. The rider on the #3, “Loita,” Alberto Delgado, was changed to Joshua Navarro; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #4, “Victory Ghost,” Sheldon Russell, was changed to Abel Castellano Jr.; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #6, “Jamie’s Ticket,” Carlos Esquilin, was changed to Martin Solis; no double jocks mount. #5, “Nolita,” was claimed by King Star – Juan Vazquez. The #8, “Ring Ring,” Javier Santiago broke though the gate prior to the start, and was immediately caught by the outrider. “Ring Ring” was returned to the starting gate where it was examined by Dr. Kathleen Picciano advising in her opinion, that the horse was fit to race. Jockey Santiago was uninjured, as he was never unseated. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 4 - 8.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #6, “Just Jazzy,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. #3, “Dinner in Odem,” and #5, “R. B. Float,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #12, “Shamroge,” was scratched as a main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 8 - 2 - 9.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m. The rider on the #2b, “Forgotten Knott,” Sheldon Russell, was changed to Julian Pimentel; no double jocks mount. #1, “Parody,” and #2, “A Student,” were scratched as part of same-owner entries. #3, “Tappinintovictory,” and #5, “Elkhorn Creek,” were vet scratches. #7, “Cherokee Artist,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2b - 7 - 6 – 1a.” Starters - 5**

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - “THE NICK SHUK MEMORIAL OVERNIGHT STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m. The rider on the #7, “Incognito Bandito,” Sheldon Russell, was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr.; no double jocks mount. **INQUIRY IN STRETCH –** Hold and claim of foul by the #6, “Private Tutor,” Wesley Ho, against the #4, “Special Skills,” Abel Castellano Jr. for carrying him out down the stretch. After reviewing the films and talking to the riders involved, the #4 horse was getting out during the stretch run carrying the #6 to the outside fence and impeding his progress. Consequently, #4 was disqualified from first and place second behind the #6 who was moved up to first from second. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 2 - 7.” Starters – 7**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:17 p.m. #4, “Arabellas Dream,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Ovour the Rainbow,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. After a two way shake, #3, “Ovour The Rainbow,” was claimed by Cree Run Enterprises LLC – Lynn Ashby. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 5**
