Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

The Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission met this morning at 10:15 a.m.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

We received test clearances from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, August 1, and Thursday, August 2, 2012 which were all clear with one exception. Sample D-07831 collected on Wednesday, August 1, was positive for “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 2.88 micrograms per milliliter of plasma.

We requested Commission Inspector’s Mr. Francis Swift and Mr. Ramon Rodriguez to conduct a barn search this morning concerning the “PHENYLBUTAZONE,” positive. The barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer, Peter Wasiluk Jr. were inspected. Results of the search did not reveal any contraband.

**Administrative Hearings held on Tuesday, August 7, 2012:**

On Tuesday, August 7, 2012 we held a hearing for Trainer Heather Hollahan concerning her “PHENYLBUTAZONE” positive, in the amount of 5.22 micrograms per milliliter of plasma for the horse “Tropical Deputy” from the eleventh race on Saturday, July 21, 2012. Ms. Hollahan was assessed a penalty of a five hundred (\$500.00) dollar fine, and a seven (7) day suspension. In addition the horse “Tropical Deputy” will be disqualified from all purse money. Ms. Hollahan was given her appeal rights, and will get back to us within forty eight hours.

On Tuesday, August 7, 2012 we held a hearing for Trainer Hugh McMahon concerning a claiming rule violation, running the horse “Stolen Chevy” at Penn National before the sixty (60) day limitation of running in another jurisdiction had expired. Mr. McMahon will be assessed a penalty of a one-thousand (\$1000.00) dollar fine, for this violation.

On Tuesday, August 7, 2012 we held a reinstatement hearing for Assistant Trainer Mr. Bradley Hedges. Mr. Hedges will be reinstated with a conditional license as of Tuesday, August 7, 2012.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:15 p.m.** #5, “Grand Circle,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #1, “Derbydaygirl,” was eased at the top of the stretch by its rider, Javier Santiago. We contacted the rider to ask why the horse was pulled up. Mr. Santiago said the horse was not sore, but just quit and would not run after going five-eighths of a mile. Dr. Jane Teichner examined the horse and informed the Stewards that “Derbydaygirl,” had mild arrhythmia. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 6**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:42 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:45 p.m.** #3, “Borderland,” and #9, “Curlamorous,” were vet scratches. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 7**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:10 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:11 p.m.** #2, “Max Again,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Copper Tiger,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 4**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:36 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:38 p.m.** #6, “Franstein,” and #9, “Little Pinkie,” were scratched as main-track only. #7, “Cat N Caboodle,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 7**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:03 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:04 p.m.** Angel Suarez, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Halo Hollie,” was changed to Victor Rodriguez; no double jocks mount. #2, “Just Say Goodbye,” and #5, “Sister Gertrude,” were vet scratches. #6, “Wild Kay,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “Who Loves Ya Baby,” was claimed by PTK LLC – Dane Kobiskie. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 7 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 6**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:30 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:31 p.m.** #1, “Scipabeat,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Barbara,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #6, “Yoo Hoo Too,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 6**

**SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:57 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:02 p.m.** #1, “Headingtothecity,” was a vet scratch. #9, “Maharani Ursula,” was scratched as a main-track only. #5, “Strategic Defense,” ridden by Forest Boyce, broke though the gate prior to the start, was caught by the outriders, and returned to the starting gate. “Strategic Defense” was examined by Dr. Jane Teichner and relayed that the horse was fit to race. Jockey Forest Boyce was uninjured, as she was never unseated. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 4 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 7**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:27 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:28 p.m.** #3, “Good Girls Dont,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 10 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 9**

**NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:54 p.m.** #1, “Goods Gone West,” and #3, “Has Determination,” were vet scratches. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **INQUIRY AT START** - #6, “Bobcat Jim,” stumbled the second jump out of the gate and unseated its rider, Jose Caraballo. Mr. Caraballo was examined by EMT Antonio Morales who said that Jockey Caraballo was ok to continue riding. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 4**

**TENTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:21 p.m.** The rider on the #1, “Burnin Rubber,” Gregorio Rivera, was changed to Jorge Rodriguez; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 8 - 3 – 2b.” Starters - 10**
