Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

We received test clearances from Dalare Associates Inc., for Saturday, August 4, and Monday, August 6, 2012 which were all clear, with two exceptions. Sample D-7795 collected on Saturday, August 4, 2012 was positive for “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 3.16 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. Sample D-6953 collected on Monday, August 6, 2012, is on hold by the official laboratory for further testing.

We requested Commission Inspectors Francis Swift and Ramon Rodriguez to conduct a barn search this morning concerning the “Phenylbutazone” positive. The barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer, Jose Nunez were inspected. Results of the search did not reveal any contraband. A bottle of Phenylbutazone pills which could be related to the positive test, was discovered. Mr. Nunez came in this morning, and was advised of his right to a split sample and hearing options for the violation. Mr. Nunez waived his right to a split sample and hearing and will be issued a five-hundred (\$500.00) dollar fine for a first violation of rule #15.1.3.1.5”Test levels for Phenylbutazone.”

**THIRD RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:15 p.m.** #2, “Dixie Shoes,” #4, “Media Madness,” #5, “Grant Park,” #7, “Christmas Cove,” and #8, “Mykindofladyfriend,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. We canceled Place, Show, Exacta, Trifecta, and Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below four betting interests. #3, “Tatum Tot,” was selected for a Stewards special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 3**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:45 p.m.** #2, “Chuckie’s Honor,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Trappist Monk,” was selected for a Stewards special test. #8, “Shamroge,” was claimed by Hugh H. Robertson – McClean Robertson. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 1 - 7.” Starters - 8**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m.** #6, “Simmadownnow,” was selected for a blood gas test. #6, “Simmadownnow,” flipped in the starting gate. The rider, Jose Caraballo, was examined by the EMT Matt Paladinetti at first aid, recommending that jockey Caraballo should take a race off before returning to ride. Associate Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner informed us that the horse “Simmadownnow,” had hit the back of the gate very hard sustaining abrasions to its back. Subsequently, Dr. Teichner recommended the horse be scratched. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 7**

**SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:50 p.m.** The rider on the #4, “Jose Caraballo, was changed to Abel Castellano Jr., as Mr. Caraballo is sitting this race out; no double jocks mount will be charged. #1, “Copla De Oro,” was scratched as the horse was not eligible for the race. #3, “Trouble in Love,” and #9, “Lovely Counselor,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #10, “Moms R Special,” #11, “Storm Palm (ARG),” #12, “Bayside Seabrez,” and #14, “First Friend,” were scratched as alternates. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 8 - 7.” Starters - 7**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m.** #9, “C. Lady’s Warrior,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Flashy Bullet,” was claimed by Linda Payne – August Martin. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 10 - 1 - 7.” Starters - 9**

**EIGHTH RACE – “THE STONEWALL FARM OCALA UNBRIDLED BELL OVERNIGHT STAKES” - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:53 p.m.** #7, “Marcie Lee,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. #5, “Romantic Cuvee,” flipped in the starting gate. The rider, Sheldon Russell, had stepped off the horse and was uninjured. Associate Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner informed us that the horse “Romantic Cuvee,” had abrasions and cut its right stifle and recommended the horse be scratched. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 8 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 8**
