FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. The rider on the #1, "Beckon the Queen," Jonathan Joyce, was changed to Richard Monterrey; no double jocks mount. #2, "Don't Look Down," #4, "Is That Blue," and #6, "A True Imperialism," were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #3, "Derwin County," who was ridden by Sheldon Russell, was eased at the three-eighths pole. The #3, "Derwin County," was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, who said the horse had broken a bone in its right front leg. Dr. Peters applied a splint to the leg, and requested the horse ambulance to return the horse to its stall. The horse will be diagnosed further, by private practitioner Dr. Liam Clerkin. * Update: Dr. Peters called us just before the fifth race, telling us the horse had broken its right knee and was humanely destroyed. **ORDER OF FINISH – "8 - 7 - 5 - 1." Starters - 5**
