Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, August 15, and Thursday, August 16, 2012, were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 3:30 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:31 p.m. #1, “Cobbler’s Mark,”
was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 3:58 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:59 p.m. #5, “Yesterday’s
Story,” and #7, “West Birch,” were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this
race as we were below six betting interest. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 6 - 2.” Starters**

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:26 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:28 p.m.
During the race, the rider on the #1, “Simba Bahari,” Jose Caraballo, was unable to control
the horse, as the horse was running off throwing its head in the air, running up on the heels of
the horses in front of him. Following the race while Jockey Caraballo was unsaddling the
horse, the trainer, F.E. Hunter engaged in a heated discussion with the rider. Commission
Inspector, Rodriguez had to intervene to prevent Mr. Hunter from escalating the incident and
quell further shouting. It was reported to us that Caraballo had to be personally escorted to
the jockey’s room while Mr. Hunter who was then joined by his wife, Heather Hunter,
continued to direct unpleasant language towards the rider. Mr. and Mrs. Hunter will be
summoned before the Stewards for their actions concerning this incident. #6, “March Ink,”
was scratched, due to an expired coggins. #10, “Bustarella,” #11, “Rocket Reign,” #12,
“Tracey Pal Friday,” #13, “Love the Heat,” and #14, “Umpee,” were scratched as alternates.
