Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:50 p.m. #1a, “El Pichon,” was scratched as a main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 2 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 10**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:22 p.m. #1, “Queen Bee Teresa,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Queen Bee Teresa,” was claimed by Malone Racing – Brian Malone. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:51 p.m. #1a, “Soft Ball,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Roaring Junebug,” was a vet scratch. #4, “It’s Purple Rain,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 – 2b - 6 - 1.” Starters - 6**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:24 p.m. #1, “Yes Papi Yes,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #10, “Wandering Kitten,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3 “Smash and Grab,” was claimed by Kryskaly Horse Racing Inc – Julio Cartagena. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 10 - 4.” Starters - 10**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:53 p.m. #5, “Hyarima,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Awesome Mich,” was scratched in the post parade by Chief Commission Veterinarian, John Peters for being off in the right front. **INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START** – The #3, “Who Dat Boy,” ridden by Victor Carrasco, shied from the #1, “Myrasira,” with rider Natasha Coddington shortly after the start, forcing the field out which caused the #6, “Pot of Gold,” ridden by Angel Serpa to clip heels. As the #3 had finished last, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 6 - 8.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:25 p.m. #5, “Entheos,” was selected for a blood gas test. #13, “Chief Exchanger” and #14, “Street Credit,” were scratched as alternates. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 11 - 12 - 7.” Starters - 12**
