Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, June 5, 2013, were all clear.

Associate Commission Veterinarian Kathleen Picciano is substituting for Dr. Jane Teichner. The infield tote-board is down for the day due to electrical problems caused by weather conditions earlier in the week.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #6, “Nuestra Senor,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2, “Mtsthelensspirit,” was claimed by Larry Rabold – Shellaine Brown. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Jeremy Rose, the scheduled rider on the #4, “One French Kiss,” was changed to Jose Vega; no double jocks mount. #1, “Quiet Favorite,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Dancingwithstones” and #3, “Fast Exchange,” were vet scratches. #5, “Mike the Leader,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. We canceled Show, Trifecta and Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 – 1a - 4 - 6.” Starters - 4**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #2, “Joint Custody,” was a vet scratch. **INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START** – Claim of foul by the rider of the #3, “Tiz Showbiz,” Martin Solis, against the #4, “Mr. Rover,” with rider Victor Carrasco, for coming in and taking all his room away. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards disqualified the #6, “Chili Bean,” with rider Jose Caraballo from third and placed him fourth, behind the #3 who was moved up to third. The #6 drifted in forcing the #4 in causing the #3 to check his horse. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #2, “She’s My Afleet” #5, “Swoop” #6, “Gigi’s Speed” and #7, “Candy Dance,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #8, “Blinding Ruby,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:19 p.m. #5, “Lastochka,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 6 - 8.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:50 p.m. #1, “Controlled Neglect” #4, “Enchanted Dreams” #8, “Mavourneen” and #9, “Get the Picture,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 5**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:22 p.m. #3, “Mad Magic,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Luna Luna,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Ericafromamerica,” with rider Silvia Zapico fell after the race pulling up. The horse was caught by the outriders and returned to the unsaddling area. The rider Ms. Zapico was transported by ambulance to hospital for evaluation. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 7 - 8.” Starters - 7**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:53 p.m. #6, “C C Cold,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 5:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:24 p.m. Silvia Zapico, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Top Partner,” was changed to Pedro Nazario; no double jocks mount. #1, “Hero’s Notion” #4, “Love’s Not Fair” and #8, “Rapsallion,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #3, “Macho Gris,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 2 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 7**
