Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for June 6, June 8, and June 10, 2013 were all clear with one exception. Sample #D-9392 retained from the horse, "TRUMAN'S COMMANDER" which ran in the 2nd race on June 6, 2013, tested positive excessive levels of "Phenylbutazone," in the amount of 6.35 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. Commission Inspector's Swift and Delaney conducted a barn search of trainer Kenny P. Smith regarding the positive test. Inspection of the barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer Smith revealed "Phenylbutazone" powder and paste. An interview of subject's veterinarian, Dr. Hawk was also conducted. Subsequently, trainer Smith appeared before the Stewards and waived his right to a split sample. A hearing will be scheduled for June 25, 2015 at 11:00 a.m.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1a, "Think I'm Hooked," was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #8, "Sutton Road," was a vet scratch.
ORDER OF FINISH – "4 - 6 - 8 - 1." Starters - 7

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – "5 - 3 - 7 – (2-8) Dead Heat." Starters - 8

THIRD RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #1, "Absolute Crackers (IRE)" #3, "Dinner's Out (GB)" and #8, "Charged Cotton," were scratched as this race is off the turf. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – "4 - 6 - 5 - 2." Starters - 5**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #1, “Super Saturday,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Turbin,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 6**

FIFTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. The distance for this race has been modified from the original seven and one half furlongs on the turf, to one mile on the main track. Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Miss Pavarotti,” was changed to Jose Caraballo; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Donttangowithmango” #3, “Kukosa” #6, “Calliope” #8, “Pi Bella” #9, “R Vicarious Girl” #10, “Pink Sapphire” and #12, “Glorious Notion,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #2, “Back for Dinner,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m. Silvia Zapico, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Oilton,” was changed to Erasmo Martinez; no double jocks mount. Victor Carrasco, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Trappist Monk,” was changed to Pedro Nazario; no double jocks mount. #9, “Modern Cowboy,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 5 - 9 - 1.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – THE OBEAH STAKES (Grade III) - POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:22 p.m. Alex Cintron, the scheduled rider on the #6, “And Why Not,” was changed to Joshua Navarro; no double jocks mount. All horses for this race were pre-race blood gas tested. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – THE GO FOR WAND STAKES - POST TIME – 4:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:53 p.m. #1, “Disco Barbie” #6, “Golden Joop” and #7, “Off My Cloud,” were scratched as this is a stakes race. All horses for this race were blood gas tested. #9, “What You Know,” was eased in the stretch. The #9 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, who stated that the horse pulled ligaments in her right rear ankle. Dr. Brown requested the horse be removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 8 - 2.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE –POST TIME – 5:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:23 p.m. #1a, “Sing the Blues,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Sweet Palmetto,” was selected for a blood gas test. After a three-way shake, #1, “Cherylwithans,” was claimed by Helen Marshall – Kieron Magee. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 9**
