**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 3 - 7.” Starters - 7**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE START - #5, Forgetthefantasy,” Martin Solis stumbled at the start unseating the rider. No action was taken regarding the inquiry. The rider Mr. Solis was checked by E.M.T. Kerri Lancaster, signing a refusal of treatment form to return riding. #4, “Anna’s Gimlet,” was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 7**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #1a, “All Born Sinners,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #5, “Risky Red,” was scratched as the horse was ineligible, due to being claimed, in Maryland. #1, “Awesome Mich,” was claimed by Reyes Segredo Family Stable – Alejandro Reyes. ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 8**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #1a, “Political Miss,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #6, “Maxine’s Pride,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed #6, “Maxine’s Pride,” requested a \$175.00 dollar all inclusive special test. A claim in for the #6, “Maxine’s Pride,” by Mr. Raul Arriagada was “VOID” as the claimant lacked sufficient funds in his horsemen’s account. #7, Pure Light,” was pulled up after the race, being removed from the racing surface via the horse ambulance. Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner called, stating that she could see nothing wrong with the #7, Pure Light,” when she arrived. ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 8**

**SIXTH RACE – (THE OUR MIMS STAKE –1<sup>st</sup> Division-) - POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m.** #6, “Petit Trianon,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. #1, “Broomsage,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 6**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m.** The rider on the #1a, “Almost English,” Jose Caraballo, was changed to Frankie Pennington; no double jocks mount. #5, “St John’s Gospel,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Scallion,” was claimed by Mathew Groff – Hugh McMahon. The #2 “Scallion,” broke very slow for no apparent reason. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 7 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 7**
