Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for June 15, June 8, and June 17, 2013 were all clear.

Sample #D-7987 retained from the horse, “Next Level” which ran in the 7th race on June 12, 2013 which was on hold from Dalare Associates for further testing, was positive for “Clenbuterol,” and “Dextromethorphan.” The trainer of this horse, Ms. Susan Tapia is stabled in Maryland. Ms. Tapia was contacted by the Stewards, to schedule a hearing.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Narbona Pass,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Spellit” and #6, “Elkhorn Creek,” were vet scratches. #1a, “Oopers Here,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “Yano,” was claimed by King Star – Juan Vazquez. **INQUIRY AT TOP OF STRETCH** – Claim of foul by the #4, “Gotta Go Gold,” rider Daniel Centeno, against the #7, “Yano,” rider Jevian Toledo, for coming in bumping his horse, at the top of the stretch. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 – 1a - 5.”**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:49 p.m. #3, “Hanky Doodle,” was scratched by the racing-office. **INQUIRY IN STRETCH** – Claim of foul by the #4, “Namron,” Joshua Navarro, against the #8, “Native Wave,” Alex Cintron, for coming out bumping him in the stretch. After talking to the riders and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #8 from first, placing him second behind the #4 who was moved up to the winner’s position. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 8 - 7 - 6.”**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. Brian Pedroza, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Kazachka,” was changed to Carlos Esquilin. #1, “Breilin,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 8 - 6 - 5.”** **Starters - 7**

Luis Colon, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Jazz,” was changed to Abel Castellano Jr. #2, “Chanterelle” #3, “Our Gin Mill” #9, “Will n’ Pat” #10, “No Means No” #12, “Nekia’s Vow” and #14, “Ericafromamerica,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **INQUIRY IN STRETCH – – Claim of foul by the #6, “Miss Lamour,” Alex Cintron, against the #1, “Jazz,” Abel Castellano Jr., for coming out in the stretch causing him to check his horse. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 11 - 13.” Starters - 8**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:53 p.m. #1a, “Star Holiday,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 7**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:23 p.m. #4, “Amazing Cheri MHF,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Geraldine MHF,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2b - 6 - 1 – 2 - 3.” Starters - 8**
