The hearing scheduled for Tuesday, June 25, 2013 for trainer Mr. Kenny Smith, will be re-scheduled at the trainers request. The hearing was scheduled for the “Phenylbutazone,” positive of the horse, “TRUMAN’S COMMANDER” which ran in the 2nd race on June 6, 2013, testing positive for excessive levels of “Phenylbutazone,” in the amount of 6.35 micrograms per milliliter of plasma.

#11, “Spelling Test” #12, “Pennie My Love” #13, “Proud Dame” and #14, “Free d’Or,” were
scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #7, “Take It Inside,” was selected for a blood gas
test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 8 - 4.” Starters - 10**

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:24 p.m. Erasmo Martinez, the
rider on the #3, “TA Dirtee Dancing,” was changed to Robert Paz. Jockey Erasmo Martinez
was sent to first aid to have his arm looked at, he said he had hurt it when coming out of the
starting gate in the first race. EMT Antonio Morales called stating that Mr. Martinez was
examined, signing a refusal of treatment form. #1, “C Louise,” was scratched as part of a
