**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.** Jose Caraballo, the scheduled rider on the #7, “II Divo,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. #5, “Nico the Champ,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 3 - 4.”** **Starters - 8**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m.** #3, “Jericho Call,” was scratched, as the trainer, Nasib Rahim is under suspension for financial obligations in Pennsylvania. #5, “Powder Springs,” was a vet scratch. **FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m.** J.D. Acosta, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Smart Sequoyah,” was changed to Joshua Navarro; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Stuandlo,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Five Stones,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Game Day,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 2 - 5.”** **Starters - 6**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m.** #9, “Biker Chick,” was a vet scratch. **INQUIRY AT THE START –** Hold and claim of foul by the #5, D.A. Storm,” with rider Victor Rodriguez, against the #6, “Go Miss U S A,” with rider Daniel Centeno. The claim of foul was lodged against the #6, for allegedly coming in shutting him off shortly after the start. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 8**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 6**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m.** Joel Santiago, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Olympic Medallist,” was changed to Oliver Castillo; no double jocks mount. #3, “Henny Loves Shrimp” and #7, “Sandbag,” were vet scratches. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 8 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 6**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m.** #1a, “Superstitious Love,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Vinoteca,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #2, “Sweet Yulianna,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 6**

**NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:16 p.m.** #5, “MD Sugar and Spice,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START –** The #4, “Adios Vacquero” threw his head just as the race started, trapping his head behind the bar on the gate; no action was taken. We also spoke with Starter, Glen Menarde and the jockey Victor Rodriguez who confirmed what we had viewed on the film. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 8**
