One Jockey was selected today for random drug testing. Tests for the Jockey were negative for controlled substances.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #5, “Kodiak Song,”** was scratched, as the horse was late for Salix treatment. #7, “Diversification,” was scratched by the trainer, due to heat related issues. #6, “Master of Humor,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 5**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Jorge A. Vargas Jr.,** the scheduled rider on the #2, “Torchia Girl,” was changed to Robert Paz. #1, “Is That Blue,” was a vet scratch. **INQUIRY IN DEEP STRETCH - #3, “Morluc’s Girl,”** fell just before the finish line for no apparent reason unseating its rider, Jose Vega. EMT Amy Towbridge called stating the Mr. Vega was examined signing a refusal of treatment form and returned to the jockey’s quarters. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 7 - 8.” Starters - 7**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH**  
**– “5 - 4 – 1a - 2.” Starters - 7**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. INQUIRY STRETCH -** Claim of foul by the rider of the #4, “Premium Justice,” Josue Arce, against the #1, “Strong Indian,” Angel Castillo Jr., for coming out in front of him in the stretch, causing him to check his horse. After talking to the riders and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #1 from first, placing him fifth behind the #4, who was moved up to fourth. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 7**

**FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m.** #1, “Fragancia,” was scratched as a main-track only. #2, “Rhetorical Question” and #8, “Michelle’s Trip,” were vet scratches. #4, “Glorious Notion” #7, “Rewarding Moment” and #12, “Tatum Tot,” were scratched by the trainers, due to heat related issues. #10, “War Prospector” was scratched at 12 minutest to post by its trainer, due to heat related issues. A claim in for the #10, “War Prospector” was VOID as the horse was scratched. **ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 9 - 6 - 5.” Starters - 5**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m.** Ryan Curatolo, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Malicious,” was changed to Robert Paz. #4, “Peace Cat,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Peaceadaaction” and #6, “Flying Forward,” were scratched by their trainers, due to heat related issues. #3, “Malicious,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Show, Trifecta, and Superfecta, wagering for this race as we were bellow five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 3 - 2.” Starters - 4**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m.** Daniel Coa, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Our Silver Crown,” was changed to Jose Vega. Ivan Perez, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Shock Appeal,” was changed to Eddie Jurado. #2, “Jive Partner,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #4, “Bfit,” was a vet scratch. #10, “Safely Ashore,” was scratched by its trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 3 - 8 - 6.” Starters - 8**

**EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m.** Jeremy Rose, the scheduled rider on the #7, “More Than Sweet,” was changed to Matthew Rispoli #9, “Flash Fever,” was scratched as a main-track only. #1, “Miss Dayna Lee,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Miss Dayna Lee,” was selected for a Stewards special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 8**

**NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:16 p.m.** #1, “Sandals,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 6**
